D) Homes in Jupiter

Apes(猿) and monkeys live in the rain forests. The apes live mostly in Africa and Asia, as Old World monkeys. Monkeys that live in South America are called New World monkeys. They are both primates (灵长类动物). Do you know how to tell an ape from a monkey? It is easy. Monkeys have tails, and apes do not have tails.

The ape family includes the gorilla (大猩猩), the chimpanzee (黑猩猩), and the orangutans (长臂猿). The gorillas walk on the soles of their feet, and have long arms that reach the ground. Their knuckles (指关节) help support them, but they can stand on two legs. They eat leaves, stalks, and bamboo. Chimpanzees usually walk on fours. They eat leaves, fruit, seeds and sometimes meat. They are smart animals.

The monkey families of the rain forests include howler monkeys, spider monkeys(蜘蛛猴), and golden tamarins(小绢猴). Monkeys get around on all four legs. Some have strong tails that can hold on to a branch. Monkeys swing from vines(藤蔓) to get from one tree to another. They also eat fruit and nuts, some small bird eggs and insects.

Apes and monkeys are both gregarious. They live in groups or families. They stay together throughout their lives, and support each other. Many ape families have a leader. The leader is very strong. If another ape wants to be the leader they often fight for the position. The strongest ape will lead the group. Monkeys also live in family groups. Both apes and monkeys depend on the rainforest for survival of their families.
