《大学英语》编辑部 1994年5月 大学英语教学自从两个新《大纲》颁布、贯彻执行和四、六级全国统考以来,无论是在课程设置、教材更新、教学理论研究、教学法探讨诸方面,还是在现代化教学手段和教学设备的建设与测试考核方法的不断完善方面都是一派生机,呈现出令人可喜的景象。

在长期的教学实践和自己学习英语的过程中,我们深深感到词汇教学的重要以及掌握词语用法之艰难。有了一定的语音基础和掌握了基本的语法知识之后,词语用法就是最重要的问题了。可以说,基础阶段词汇教学的成功与否是完成或较好完成教学大纲各项基本要求的关键。只有打好比较扎实的词汇基础,才可能有成效地在听、说、读、写、译诸方面得到提高和发展,即所谓"冲霄大厦,唯赖固基",这已是学习的一般规律。为了有助于广大同学按新《大纲》的各项基本要求学好课程的主要内容,尤其是在词语用法方面打好基础、取得突破,迅速提高语言的实际综合运用能力和应试能力,我们编写了《大学英语词语用法与完形填空》一书,希望它能对同学们的词汇学习有所帮助。

本书收入的 1000 道多项选择题除部分选自己曝光的四、六级统考试题、历届研究生入学考试和近年托福考题外,绝大部分选择题是以新《大纲》为依据,密切结合日常教学实际和遵循国家考试命题的一般规律,精心设计、反复琢磨、最后编定的。本书的语言材料均选自享有较高声誉的中、外英语辞书以及最新出版的英美书刊,具有时代的气息。

本书在强调词语用法的同时,力图使所选的语言材料容纳更多的信息。语言是知识的符号,词汇是语言的基础。练习内容涉及到数学、物理、化学、生物学、天文、地理、心理学、文学、历史、法律、政治、文化教育、风土人情、新闻、体育及哲学各方面,旨在满足文理、工科同学不同专业的实际需要和鼓励知识渗透,因此本书具有极大的实用性。

本书试图采用理论联系实际的编写方法,即通过多项选择练习的方式,把《大纲》对词语用法的各项要求,如名词、形容词、副词和动词的基本用法及其与介(副)词的固定习惯搭配,同根词、

同音异义、同形异义词的误用,反义词的构成,一词多义、一些词的特殊结构功能以及语义、语体的通用性等,均结合具体练习逐一详加注释,解决疑难,力求达到掌握用法、明确概念的实用效果。

本书注释部分中的论述与观点均以国内外较权威和一致的说法为准,使其具有科学性;语言学家的不同学术见解偶尔也略有涉及,目的在于激发有兴趣同学的求知欲,使英语学习生动活泼并具有趣味性。

本书 30 篇完形填空短文均选自现代英语书刊和教科书。选材广泛、题材新颖多样,既有日常生活、民间传说、人物小传,也有社会、文化、史地常识和科普小品;既注重思想教育性,也力求具有科学性、知识性和趣味性。

本书共分三大部分:第一部分《词语用法练习》,第二部分《答案与注释》由司树森编写;第三部分《完形填空练习与答案》由袁锡兴编写,全书最后由司树森统编。在编写过程中,承《大学英语》编辑部编审夏培厚和李安林同志审改了全部书稿并出任责任编辑,首都医科大学教授宋宁先生审校了样稿,本书最后由清华大学教授、《大学英语》杂志主编李相崇同志审校;商务印书馆资深编审、著名学者、《英语世界》主编陈羽纶先生欣然为本书作序。我们由衷感激,谨在此对他们的热忱帮助和提携深致谢意。

我们对词汇学的教学与研究缺少经验,功底不足,书中疏漏、错误实为难免,敬请各方读者多加指教。
