简明实用英语系列教材是根据教育部颁发的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》编写的,包括《简明实用英语——读写教程》、《简明实用英语——听说教程》和《简明实用英语——教师用书》(每一种分为3册)。本书为《简明实用英语——听说教程(第3册)》,本书共有10个单元,每个单元由 Tune In, Listen On, Speak Out 和 Cultural Tips 等四部分组成。

本书可作为高职高专三年制或两年制公共英语教学教材,也可作为其他高等院校学生的参考读物。

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前 言

根据《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》(以下简称《基本要求》)的总体指导思想,结合高职高专英语教学实际,我们组织具有丰富高职高专教学经验的一线教师,编写了《简明实用英语——听说教程》,在坚持“以应用为目的,实用为主,够用为度”的原则下,充分注意以下几个方面:

1. 《基本要求》中的《交际范围表》所规定的听说交际主题是教材的选材依据和出发点。

2. 强调语言的交际性和真实性,注重培养学生的听说能力。以培养学生用简单而基本正确的英语表达思想的能力为目标,包括对话、会话和讨论等多种方式。

3. 强调语言的实用性,所选材料贴近生活实际,学生只要掌握了本教程的交际主题内容,就基本能够用英语参与跨文化日常生活交际。

4. 训练内容由易到难,循序渐进。练习精心设计,形式生动活泼。教学与测试相互照应,完成本教程第1、2册就可以参加“高等学校英语应用能力考试”B级中的听力考试;完成本教程第2、3册可以参加A级听力考试。

《简明实用英语——听说教程》由学生用书、教师用书以及配套的多媒体课件组成,本教程共3册,每册10个单元,每单元由Tune In、Listen On、Speak Out和Cultural Tips组成;各部分内容如下:

1) Tune In 预热准备。内容包括辨音练习、听写填空和选择题型等。

2) Listen On 听力训练。结合本单元交际主题常用功能句型,听录音、填空、填表格,并配有结合高等学校应用能力考试大纲和样题而设计的各种试题。

3) **Speak Out** 口语训练。提供具体情景进行仿真模拟口语训练，以提高口语表达能力。

4) **Cultural Tips** 文海拾贝。提供涉及西方文化的趣文，以扩大学习者的视野，提高学习英语的兴趣。

此外，每单元在 **Listen On** 部分列有重点词汇和功能句子，以帮助学生顺利完成听说任务。

本教程由承德石油高等专科学校崔秀敏担任总主编，负责全书框架的总体设计以及书稿的部分编写和审定工作。

本册主编为崔秀敏、项新宇；副主编为霍莉平、高洋、祝胜凯、崔秀香、胡智勇；参编为高小姣、李俊芬、赵嫱、郭向辉、董艳萍。

Football or Soccer

People have been playing football for over 3, 000 years. Nobody can tell where it was played for the first time. There is evidence that it was played in Japan, China, Rome and Greece. But the birthplace of modern soccer is Britain (both England and Scotland). In medieval (中世纪的) times, kicking, punching, biting and gouging were allowed. So King Edward III tried to ban football. But the game was too popular. Even Queen Elisabeth I couldn't stop it, although soccer players were jailed for a week. In 1815, the famous English School, Eton College, established a set of rules. The Football Association was founded in 1863. In 1869, any handling of the ball was forbidden. In the 1880s, students at Oxford University created a slang word for the word association. They shortened it to "SOC" and added "ER". So the word soccer was created. The same happened to Rugby (RUGGER). In 1888, the English Football League was created.
