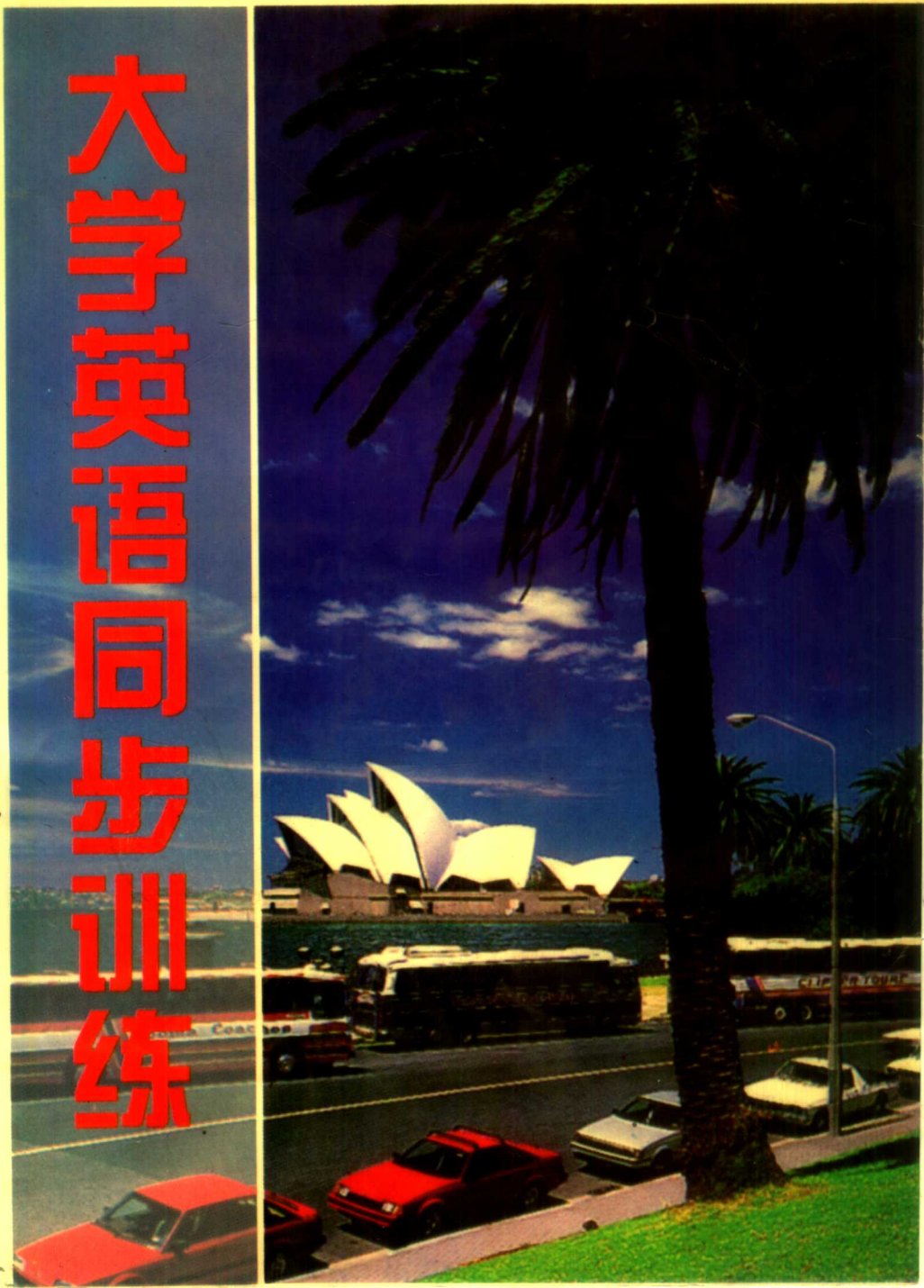

前 言

《大学英语同步训练》是根据全国通用教材《大学英语》(College English, 由复旦大学等院校编)而编写的配套测试系列书。本系列书共有四册,对应大学英语的四级测试。每册含十份测试试卷,其中五份试卷为对应课文的同步训练,另有两份试卷分别作期中、期末终结性测试,最后三份试卷为水平测试。

本书有两点独到之处。一是同步,即内容紧扣教科书,尤其是词汇、结构、完形填空、翻译、造句等项均针对相应课文中出现的难点或重点,每两单元设计一份同步测试卷;二是同级,各册的水平测试均注重学生的实际语言运用能力,重在表达、生成和运用,而非机械地选择辨认技巧,从而使测试与国家教育委员会颁发的《大学英语四级考试大纲》和《大学英语教学大纲》有机结合、要求统一。因此,使用本书不仅可方便教师进行分级教学,有效地检查学生在每个阶段的学习进展情况,而且还有助于学生复习每课所学内容,自测学习效果。

本书部分内容曾在浙江大学试用过多次,效果十分明显。

全书选材广泛,语言规范,内容丰富,循序渐进,重点难点突出,具有很强的实用性和针对性。

本书为《大学英语同步训练》的附册,汇总了各册测试卷的参考答案及听力原文。

本书适合我国在校大学本科、专科生、电大、夜大、成人高校学生及相当程度的英语自学者,并可供报考研究生、自学考试、职称英语考试、EPT 及 TOFEL 等出国考试的考生参考。

全书由李正中、童树荣总体设计。本册由于飞、夏少慧、张兴奎、李果红分别整理,李正中统稿。

在本书编稿期间,承蒙浙江省大学外语教学研究会会长张青彦教授和《大学英语》(听力)主编李慧琴教授审阅书稿,谨此一并致谢。
