# 前 言

"高等学校英语应用能力考试"于 2000 年开始在全国正式实施,参加此类考试的考生与年俱增。为了帮助考生了解考试要求和内容,并在考前熟悉所考题型、内容和难度,使考生顺利通过"高等学校英语应用能力考试"A、B 级水平的考试,我们专门编写了这套《高等学校英语应用能力考试 A、B 级全真模拟试卷及精解》。

本套试卷为 B 级考试用书,遵循国家教育部高等教育司颁布的《高等学校英语应用能力考试 大纲》和《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》而编写。本系列模拟试卷共十二套,采用全真试 卷的形式编写。

按照"考试大纲"的规定, A 级有五种题型,即:①听力理解;②语法结构;③阅读理解;④英译汉;⑤写作或汉译英。B 级也有五种题型,即:除第二部分为语法词汇外,其他的题型与 A 级相同。

B 级考试各部分的测试内容如下:

- 1. 听力理解部分测试考生对口头语言的理解,共分三节:①答问(即选答口头问题);②理解会话(即一个来回的问答);③听写。第一、二节的题型为多项选择,第三节的题型为填空听写短文(或独白)。该部分所占试卷的分值比例为 15%。
- 2. 语法词汇部分测试考生在句子层次上的语法和词汇知识,共分两节:①测试对语法规则、词汇知识的运用,题型为多项选择;②测试对句法、词法和词性(词性变化)的掌握,题型为填空。该部分所占试卷的分值比例为 15%。
- 3. 阅读理解部分设 5 个 Tasks,分别以多选题、填空题、简短回答等形式考查学生的综合阅读理解能力。该部分所占试卷的分值比例为 35%。
- 4. 英译汉部分设 4 个句子和 1 个小段落,与 A 级的同一部分相同。该部分所占试卷的分值比例为 20%。
- 5. 写作部分测试考生以英语书写应用文或填写表格的能力,内容为应用文(通告、广告、简短信函、简历表、申请书等)写作或实用性段落/短文的翻译(汉译英)。该部分所占试卷分值比例为15%。

本书在编写过程中,由于时间仓促,加上编者的水平有限,书中疏漏和错误之处在所难免,敬请广大考生和英语界的同仁不吝指正。同时我们在编写过程中参阅了大量的国内外相关资料,借鉴了一些很有价值的文章,在此我们向有关机构、作者和资料的提供者一并致以诚挚的谢意。

# 高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲(B级)

#### 一、考试对象

本大纲适用于修完《基本要求》B级所规定的全部内容的高等职业教育、普通高等专科教育、成人高等教育和本科办二级技术学院各非英语专业的学生。

#### 二、考试性质

本考试的目的是考核考生的语言知识、语言技能和使用英语处理有关一般业务和涉外交际的 基本能力,其性质是教学一水平考试。

#### 三、考试方式与内容

考试方式为笔试,包括五个部分:听力理解、语汇用法和语法结构、阅读理解、翻译(英译汉)和写作(或汉译英)。考试范围限于《基本要求》B级所规定的全部内容。

### 第一部分:听力理解(Listening Comprehension)

测试考生理解所听问题并做出恰当回答的能力、理解简短对话的能力和听写词语的能力。听力材料的语速为每分钟100词。

听力材料以日常交际和简单的业务交际内容为主。词汇限于《基本要求》的"词汇表"中 B 级 2,500 词的范围,交际内容涉及《基本要求》中的"交际范围表"所列的 B 级听力的范围。

本部分的得分占总分的15%。测试时间为15分钟。

## 第二部分:词汇用法和语法结构(Vocabulary and Structure)

测试考生运用词语和语法知识的能力。测试范围限于《基本要求》中的"词汇表"B级(2,500词)和"语法结构表"所规定的全部内容。本部分的得分占总分的15%。测试时间为15分钟。

# 第三部分:阅读理解(Reading Comprehension)

测试考生从书面文字材料获取信息的能力。总阅读量约800词。

本部分测试的文字材料以一般性阅读材料(科普、文化、社会、常识、经贸、人物等)为主,也包括简单的应用性文字,不包括诗歌、小说、散文等文学性材料,其内容能为各专业学生所理解。

阅读材料涉及的语言技能和词汇限于《基本要求》中的"阅读技能表"中与 B 级要求相应的技能范围和"词汇表"B 级中 2,500 词的范围;阅读材料涉及的应用性内容限于《基本要求》中"交际范围表"B 级所规定的读译范围,如:便条、通知、简短信函、简明广告、简明说明书、简明规范等。

主要测试以下阅读技能:

- 1. 了解语篇和段落的主旨和大意。
- 2. 掌握语篇中的事实和主要情节。...
- 3. 理解语篇上下文的逻辑关系。
- 4. 了解作者的目的、态度和观点。
- 5. 根据上下文正确理解生词的意思。

- 6. 了解语篇的结论。
- 7. 进行信息转换。

本部分的得分占总分的35%。测试时间是40分钟。

第四部分:翻译——英译汉(Translation——English into Chinese)

测试考生将英语正确译成汉语的能力。所译材料为句子和段落,包括一般性内容(约占 60%)和实用性内容(各约占 40%);所涉及的词汇限于《基本要求》的"词汇表"中 B 级(2,500 词)的范围。

本部分的得分占总分的20%。测试时间为25分钟。

第五部分:写作/汉译英(Writing/Translation——Chinese into English)

测试考生套写应用性短文、填写英文表格或翻译简短的实用性文字的能力。本部分的得分占总分的15%。测试时间为25分钟。测试项目、内容、题型及时间分配表:

Psychology is the study of the mind and mental activities. For example, psychologists are interested in why some things make you sad, but others make you happy. test intelligence.

Psychologists deal with the minds and behavior of people. Your mind consists of all your feelings, thoughts, and ideas. It is the result of one part of the brain called the cerebrum(大脑).
