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前言

本书是一本听力教材,帮助学生进行听力技能训练,提高听力。本教材分上下两册, 共由32个单元组成。

本教材的听力内容,上册包括: 住房、求职、语言学习、校园生活、娱乐、保健、电视的发明、有线电报和无线电报、环保、交通工具等; 下册包括: 医学发明、情感交流的重要性、育儿、自然与人造灾难、职业、著名景点介绍、经济投资、印象派艺术及其画家介绍等。所选材料大多来自纯正的语音资料。在内容上突破了我国传统的为训练听力而去听的思路。例如: 在谈论医学的时候,摆脱了模仿就诊、询问病情等内容,而是具体介绍显微镜的发明和使用、麻醉的发明过程等; 在谈论人群时分析人类为何有左撇子、男性女性在能力上有区别的科学根据; 在谈论通讯时,介绍了有线电报、无线电报、电视等通讯工具的发明历程和工作原理; 在接触娱乐话题时,介绍了国外最具代表性的娱乐场所、景点等。应该说,每个话题都在传统题材的话题中增加了新的内容,其目的在于弥补我国外语听力教材多注重语言和日常知识而不太注重科技知识的不足。

本教材每单元有三个部分。第一部分为热身,一般选择较为简单的对话和段落,语速相对较慢,目的是让学习者有充分的时间进入状态。第二、三部分为重点内容,通常选择较为复杂、难度较高的段落,语速相对较快,目的是让学习者在进入状态后能通过较快速的听力训练,充分发挥主观能动作用,在学习科学知识的同时,提高听力,使听力学习真正成为一种享受而非累赘。

本书练习形式多样,有填写卡片、记录数字、完善纲要、整理段落、多项选择、正误判断、回答问题等,这些正是 IELTS (雅思)、TOEFL (托福)等国外考试听力部分中最常见的练习形式,相信也是我国英语教学经过不断改革后所要追寻的目标。

本书题材广泛,知识性强,技能全面,语言自然生动,适合国内各大专院校英语专业学生及国内各大专院校已经通过四级英语考试的非英语专业学生使用。

同时,为那些想要参加 IELTS (雅思)、TOEFL (托福)等常见国外考试的学生提供基础性听力训练。

因水平有限,错漏谬误之处一定不少。恳请学习者在使用本教程时提出批评和建议,同时希望各位专家学者不吝赐教。






