

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编写说明

本书是根据 1994 年 9 月开始实行的《大学英语教学大 纲通用词汇表(1—4 级)》编写的(以下简称"四级词表"),书 中使用的词汇严格地控制在四级词表的范围之内。全书共 1360 道题,覆盖了四级词表 80%的词汇,主练词汇,即 ABCD 四个选项中的词汇达四级词表的 55%。

全书超出四级词表的词汇仅 23 个。地名、人名、及少数常见的专有名词,如 Boeing 767, Sony 等,不在计算之列,词义明显的复合词也不计为超词表词汇,如 back-yard, slowdown 等有连字符连接的, homemade, guidebook 等没有连字符的, diver, steadily 等简单的加前后缀变形,以及 high school, intellectual property 等常见词组。

本书使用美式英语,这包括拼写和用词两个方面,但有时因受到四级词表的制约,不得以使用了英式词汇,例如,四级词表中没有 pants 一词,书中只好用 trousers。

书中共含 34 套练习,分为十二种类型。每套 40 题,应该在 30 分钟内完成。

书的后半部分为详细的注释,并且在每一种类型的注释之前有个简单的提要。凡是一经查阅四级词表答案不言自明的题,均不再浪费篇幅一一注释。

书尾附有新词表超出原《高等学校文理科本科用大学英语教学大纲》(86 年版)的词汇约 470 个。
