### 序言

近年来,英语学习在青少年中早已成为经久不衰之文化活动,各类的英语课程、英语竞赛更是吸引着勤奋的学子们。外语教材教法的研究,近年来也尤其活跃:各种论文、教材、工具书纷纷问世,以应社会上学习外语的大量需求。总起来说,这仍然是好现象。粗制滥造的作品经不起时间与实践的考验,日后必然遭受淘汰。能够长远站住脚的,一定是对教学内容与方法真正下过功夫,经过深入研究而做出的成果。我国外语普及水平以及外语教学水平必将随之迅速提高,这是改革开放以前的时代无法比得上的。

林继玲、王松美、杨力红、于淑卿等同志都是北京教育学院(包括前北京市英语教师培训中心)的骨干教师。她们都曾到澳大利亚新南威尔士大学留过学,受过英语教学理论与方法的教育,回国以后,又长期从事英语教师培训工作,积累了丰富的实践经验。她们合作编写的这一套英语学习丛书,主要是为了基础较好的中学生巩固提高用的,可以自修,也可以在教师指导下学习,尤其适合准备参加各类英语竞赛的学生使用。我以为她们编书会有两个突出的优点。一是她们在教学理论观点上受过同一学派的正规培训,在教学方法和学习方法的基本原则上必然有共同的认识与默契。二是她们都有长期的教学经验,对中国学生学习英语的规律与难点,有较深的体会。

基于此,她们合作的成果必有独树一帜的特点;在英语教材与教法百家争鸣的形势下,她们的成绩必占应得的一席之地;而这也正是这套学习丛书的价值所在。

"Aeolian Bell"是一本培养英语听与说能力的教材,适用于初级阶段要在课堂英语学习的基础上进一步提高听说能力,扩大词汇量,巩固和加深对英语语法知识的了解的学生。本教材也适用于高中一年级学生和同等水平的人员。

"Aeolian Bell"按照当前世界上流行的现代语言教学方法的原则编写。听力材料多为对话,既有英语国家为语言背景的内容,也有国内日常生活为语言背景的内容,尤其是包括一些中外中学生生活为背景的对话。这样,既保证了语言的真实性、地道性,也注意了在我们特定国情中学习者的特点及需要。

为提高学生的听力技巧,本书各课编写了听力练习。听力练习一方面检查学习者的理解情况,另一方面,更重要的是要培养学生的听力技巧,引导学生首先注意了解总体的内容,再注意抓住细节,然后从学习语言的目的出发,把注意力放在句型、词汇等语言点上。本书把口头使用英语即说的能力的培养与听力的培养密切结合起来。各课在听力练习(Listening activities)后安排了说英语练习(Speaking activities)。说英语练习为学生提供了各种各样的情景,让学生从模仿听力课文中出现的句型、词汇等表达一些真实的生活内容到灵活运用英语表达自己的观点,从而提高说英语的能力,达到学以致用的效果。

本书按听力材料的内容分为 15 个单元。选材力求内容多元化,符合中学生年龄特点,注意广泛的知识性与趣味性。每单元围绕一个日常生活的专题进行听说训练。每个单元有 3—4 课。每课可独立为一个学习的单位。由于每单元围绕一个专题进行,就很自然地把这一专题中常见的词汇、短语等进行了复习并会扩大学习者的词汇量。各课听力课文中都体现了一、两个语言的功能、意念。体现功能意念的重点句型可在 Speaking activities 中得到练习。为达到检查各单元学习情况,尤其是检查听力理解水平的目的,每个单元设立了自我检测题。

"Aeolian Bell"可供学生自学,也可供英语听说课堂使用。在课堂中使用时,教师要注意按照听说课教学的步骤进行。第一步为热身,或称导入,本书各课中"Before listening"的活动即为这一步准备之材料。多数情况下,在这一步骤中,要把听力材料的语言背景、人物、地点等介绍出来,还要注意适当扫清学生在听力理解中

可能要遇到的障碍。也有的课把 Who? Where? When? 作为听力理解的第一个练习题,那么,在这一步中只要求学生对听力材料有大致的理解。这一步骤中要为听力活动扫清生词的障碍。为教与学的方便,各课都把稍高于初等水平的词汇、短语列于听力活动之前。凡在其它项活动中出现的生词,若不在听力活动中出现则不列在生词表内。第二步为学生的听力活动。这一步骤中要注意在学生听到课文前布置听力练习题或称听力任务。接下去的第三个步骤是口头练习。教师可根据学生的口头表达水平选择使用 Speaking activities 中的活动。但一般应从句型操练开始,教师逐渐减少对学生表达内容的控制,直至学生就某一内容自由表达。这一步骤中,要充分利用成对活动或小组活动的形式,以使学生有更多的练习机会。Speaking activities 中凡属 Pair work 的,务必让学生成对练习,而 Work with your partner 的活动可适当灵活进行。

"Aeolian Bell"是《英语奥林匹克(初级)》丛书中的听说篇,若与此丛书中的其它篇配合使用,相信会取得更好的效果。
