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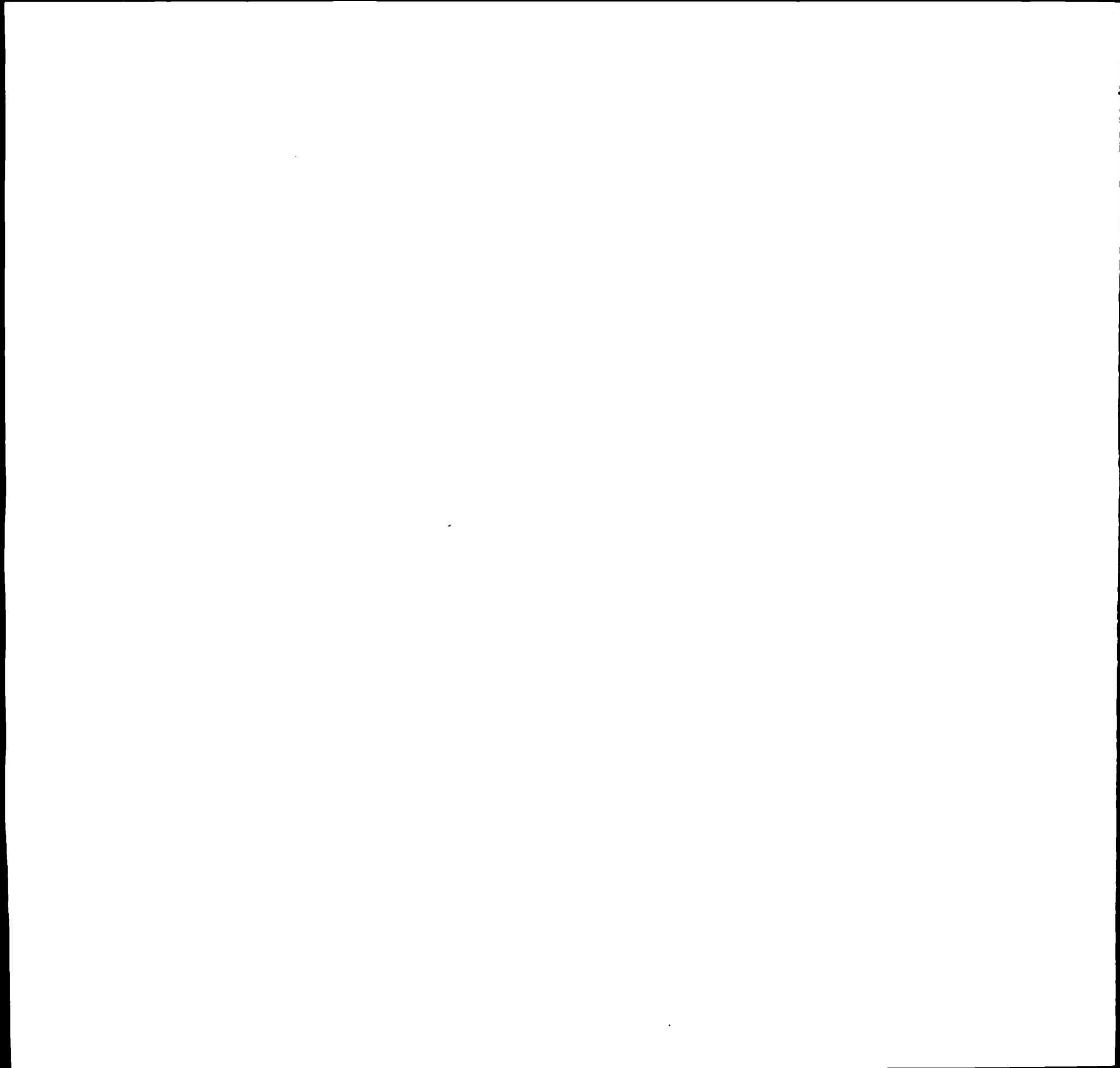

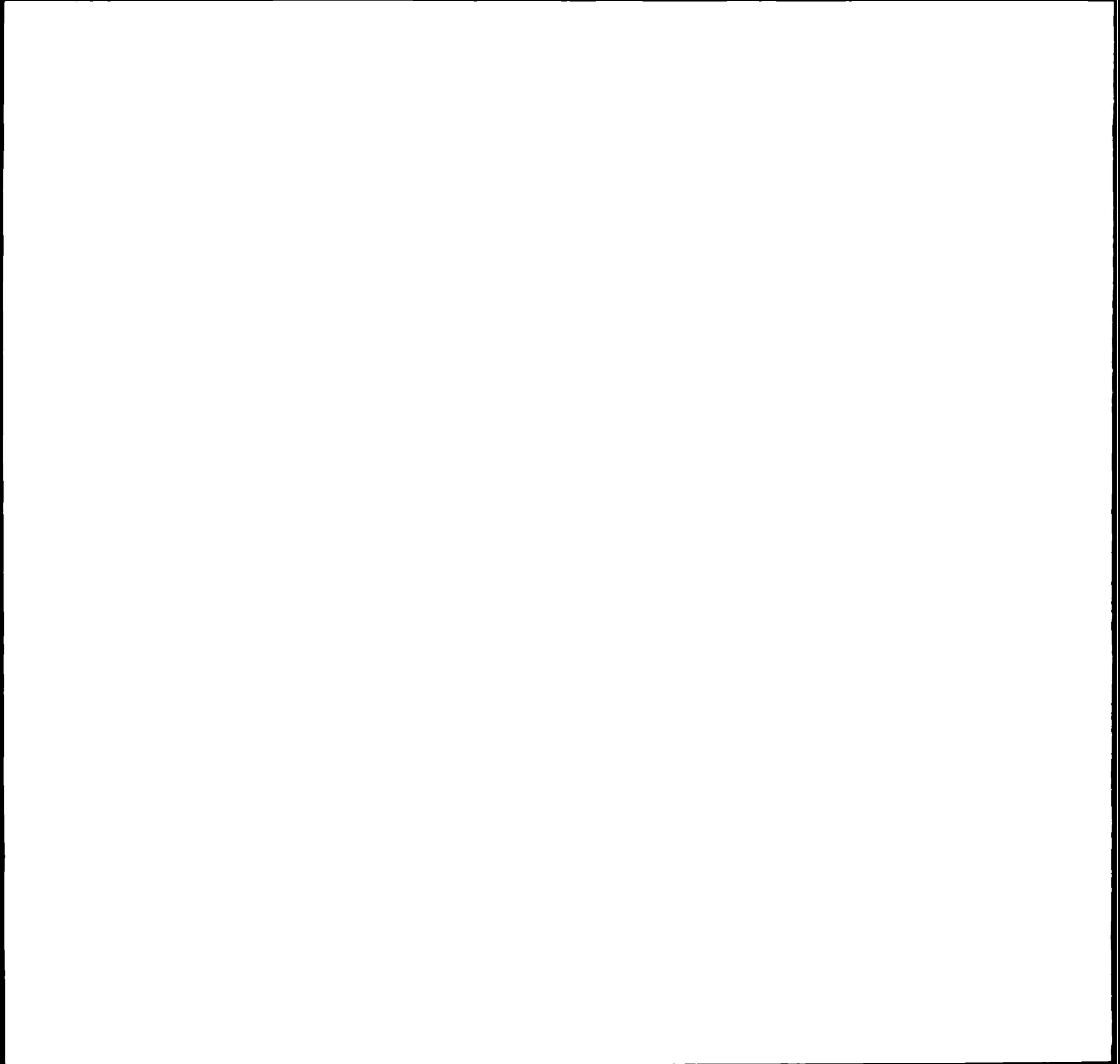

### 作者简介

梁文亮，中国美术家协会会员，现任西北大学美育教研室主任，副教授。1930年生于河南省沁阳县，幼年受过良好的艺术启蒙教育，由名家指导学习绘画多年。1954年以优异成绩毕业于西北艺术学院美术系。以后，在极端艰苦的条件下从事水彩画创作三十余年。他的作品情感真挚，朴实无华，多次选入全国及陕西省美术作品展览。中国美术家协会陕西省分会在1980年和1985年两次为他举办个人画展。他的第三次画展是在1986年7月由中国美术馆主办的，这是中国美术馆自建成以来首次为国内水彩画家举办的个人画展，展览受到了社会各界的高度评价，人民日报、光明日报、中国美术报及香港《明报》月刊等十余家报刊杂志先后对画展进行了报导和评论。

截止目前，已有15幅作品入藏中国美术馆。

### BRIEF INTRODUCTION ABOUT ARTIST

Mr. Liang Wenliang, a watercolour painter, is one of the members of the China Artist Association, an associate professor and the chairman of the Art Education Division at Northwest University.

Mr. Liang was born in Qinyang Country in Henan Province in 1930. During his childhood, he was well-educated in art enlightenment and taught painting by masters. In 1954, he graduated with excellent marks from the Department of Fine Arts at the Northwest Art College, Xi'an. Since then he has been engaged in watercolours, under very difficult circumstances, for more than thirty years. His watercolour paintings, full of his sincere emotions, are simple and unadorned. Many times the paintings have been on show at China National Art Exhibitions and Shaanxi Provincial Art Exhibitions.

In 1980 and 1985, the Shaanxi Branch of the China Artist Association held two individual watercolour exhibitions for Mr. Liang in Xi'an, respectively. His third exhibition was sponsored by the China Art Gallery in Beijing in July 1986. It was the first time that the China Art Gallery held such an individual watercolour exhibition for a Chinese painter in watercolours, since the gallery was founded. In the exhibition his works were highly appreciated, and the exhibition was continuously reported and commented on by the People's Daily, Guang Min Daily, Fine Arts in China, Hong Kong Ming Pao Monthly and more than ten other newspapers and magazines.

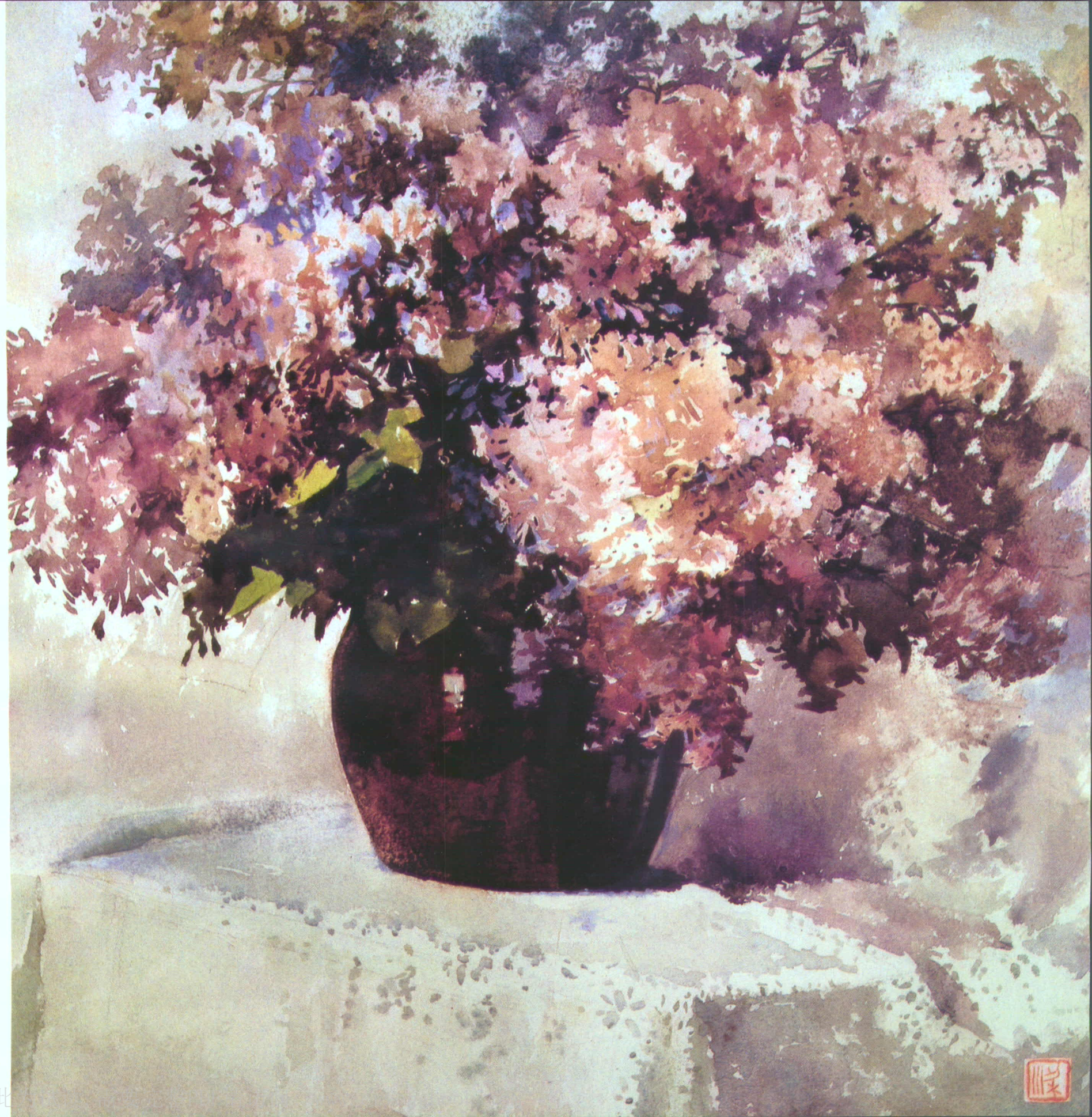
Up to now there are fifteen paintings that have been stored in the China Art Gallery, Beijing.
