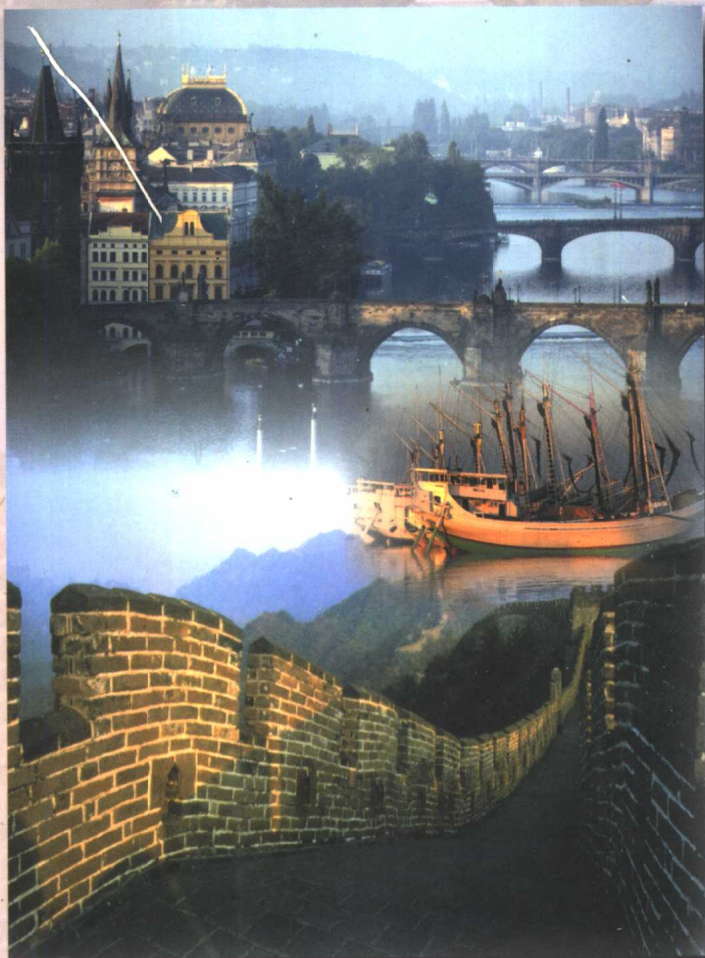

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前 言

外语教学与研究出版社近年出版了由浙江大学编写的《新编大学英语》教材。该教材采用了“以学生为中心的主题教学模式”，融听、说、读、写、译为一体。我们相信它对深化教学改革，促进和推动我国的大学英语教学将起积极的作用。我们应浙江大学出版社之约，针对《新编大学英语》教材编写了这套学习指南，旨在帮助全国各地使用该教材的学生更好地学习和巩固语言知识，增强应试能力。希望本书也能为有关教师提供一些有益的帮助。

《新编大学英语学习指南》共4册，每册依单元顺序编写；每单元的讲解分重点词汇和短语、课文注释、同步训练、参考答案及课文中译文五个部分。

重点词汇和短语——从每单元的 In-Class Reading 中精选比较重要的词(主要是四级词以及派生词)和 20~30 个短语(如果 In-Class Reading 中的词和短语不多，则从 After-Class Reading 的 Passage 中挑选)，依照课文并参考《大学英语教学大纲词汇表》(2000 年版)予以释义，然后给出例句(尽可能选自外版词典和书刊)，并配上译文，以便于学习者准确理解单词和句子含义，并模仿、学习规范语言。此外，还适当给出构词、同义、反义、搭配、辨异、考点等项。

课文注释——对课文中的长句、难句进行注释及结构分析，帮助学习者解决阅读理解上的困难。此外，对句子中出现的语法现象及某些未列入单词表的单词、短语进行详解，并提供例句及汉译。

同步练习——针对课文语言点(词汇和语法),并结合大学英语四、六级考试内容,编写了 Vocabulary 与 Structure 两部分练习,各 20 题,旨在检查学习者对课文中出现的词汇和语法的掌握程度,从而使其在四、六级统考的相关项目中取得好成绩。

参考答案——为学习者提供每一单元课本中的大部分练习的答案以及同步练习的答案。

课文译文——旨在帮助学习者正确理解每单元课内外阅读文章,同时该译文也是学习者以课文为材料进行“英译汉”技能训练的参考答案。

全书由李正中、黄会健主编,寮菲与王健倩主审。参加本册编写的有王健倩(分册主编)、黄会健、许罡和张小霞。在编写过程中,我们认真学习并借鉴了一些同类教学辅导用书的长处,在此一并致谢。对于本书的不足之处,希望读者指正。

Happiness

Part One Key Words and Phrases

1 causal

adj. 原因的, 关于因果的

They don't think there is any causal connection between unemployment and crime. 他们认为失业和犯罪之间没有任何因果关系。

He would show the causal relationship between culture and body language. 他会显示文化和体式语之间的因果关系。

【构词】cause *n. vt.* 起因

Ice on the road was the cause of the tragedy. 路上的冰引起了悲剧。

2 changeable

adj. 多变的, 易变的

His temper's been very changeable this week, so don't annoy him. 这个星期他的脾气老是变, 所以别惹他。

Don't trust her love; she is changeable. 不要相信她的爱情。她的爱很容易变。

【构词】changed *adj.* 改变的

【反义】unchanged *adj.* 不改变的

His unchanged attitude annoyed her. 他不改变态度, 使她很恼火。

unchangeable *adj.* 不可改变的

【辨异】changed 与 changeable 的区别在于: 前者只强调“改变的”, 而后者强调“多变的”。

3 committed

adj. 坚定的, 投身的, 献身的, 忠诚的

Jean's a committed nurse. 珍妮是一个很有责任心的护士。

Allan has been committed to equal rights for women for many years. 多年来, 阿伦致力于争取妇女的平等权利。

4 competing

adj. 抵触的, 相互矛盾的

They talked about the competing theories of the extinction of the animals. 他们谈到有关动物灭绝的相互矛盾的理论。

【同义】contradictory *adj.* 相互矛盾的

They have made contradictory statements about the equipment. 关于这个设备的问题, 他们的说法是相互矛盾的。

5 exterior

adj. 外部的, 外面的

The exterior walls of the building was a masterpiece of elegance and grace. 大楼的外墙极为高雅、优美。

Unit One

The exterior wall of the prison is dark gray. 监狱的外墙呈深灰色。

n. 外部, 外表, 外貌

We are painting the exterior of the house. 我们在粉刷房屋的外墙。

It is difficult to judge a person by his exterior. 很难根据外表判断人。

【反义】 *interior adj. n.* 内部的; 内部

The outside of the school needs to be decorated, but the interior is in excellent condition. 学校的外部需要修缮, 而内部已经很不错了。

6 lasting

adj. 持久的, 永久的, 耐久的

His policies had a lasting effect on our country's economy. 他的政策对我国的经济有持久的影响。

This experience threw a lasting shadow on his life. 这个经历在他生活中投下了长久的阴影。

He had a lasting interest in art. 他一直对艺术感兴趣。

【同义】 *permanent adj.* 永恒的, 持久的

The roof gives permanent protection against heavy rain. 房顶能够持久地挡住大雨。

【反义】 *temporary adj.* 暂时的

You have to find temporary jobs during your summer holidays. 你得在暑假中找临时工作。

7 mythical

adj. 想像的, 虚构的

He is the mythical hero of ancient Greece. 他是古希腊传说中的英雄。



This was a mythical beast that had seven or more heads. 这是个虚构的野兽,有七个或更多的头。

【同义】imaginary *adj.* 假想的,想像的

All the characters in this novel are imaginary. 这部小说中所有的人物都是虚构的。

【构词】myth *n.* 神话,神话式的人物

The child is lost in the world of stories about magic and myth. 这孩子沉浸在充满魔术和神话的故事世界中。

8 restraint

n.

1) 克制,抑制,限制

You showed great restraint in not hitting Peter after what he said. 彼德说了那些话后,你很有克制力,没有打他。

There is restraint in smoking in the public places. 公共场所吸烟有限制。

The wise man exercises great restraint in his behavior. 明智的人克制自己的行为。

2) 约束措施,约束条件

Lack of money and lack of machinery are two restraints on the growth of this firm. 缺少资金和机器这大约束限制了公司的发展。

He hates the restraint of life in a small town. 他讨厌小城镇中生活上的约束。

【构词】restrain *vt.* 约束

If you can not restrain your dog from biting people, you must lock it up. 如果你不能管好狗,让它不咬人,那就必须把它锁起来。

【同义】limit *n. vt.* 局限;限制

Unit One

I can not run 10 miles; I know my limits. 我跑不了 10 英里。我知道我的局限。

We must limit our spending. 我们必须限制花费。

9 supportive

adj. 起支持作用的, 支援的

They were always supportive of each other. 他们彼此一直互相支持。

My classmates were so supportive when I had great difficulty. 当我有很多困难时, 同学都很帮忙。

The boss was very supportive and gave her time off work to see her sick mother. 老板很帮忙, 放了她的假, 让她去看生病的母亲。

【构词】support *vt.* 支持

10 virtuous

adj. 有道德的, 善良的, 正直的

Louis is a virtuous, intelligent and responsible young man. 路易斯是个有道德、聪明和负责人的年轻人。

Everyone should seek to lead a virtuous life. 每个人都要努力在生活中成为正直的人。

【构词】virtue *n.* 美德

Among her many virtues are loyalty, courage, and truthfulness. 她有很多美德, 其中有忠诚、勇敢和坦率。

virtuously adv. 有道德地, 善良地

11 defect

n. 缺点, 缺陷, 毛病

Before they leave the factory, all the cars are carefully tested for defects. 离开工厂前, 所有的小汽车都经过仔细的测试, 以检验是否有问题。



This old man has got a hearing defect. 老人听力有缺陷。

The report has pointed out the defects of the present system. 报告指出了现行制度的缺陷。

【同义】shortcoming *n.* 缺点

In spite of all her shortcomings I still think she is one of the best secretaries. 尽管有很多缺点,我仍然认为她是最好的秘书之一。

12 fluently

adv. 流利地,流畅地

Mary did not read fluently until she was six. 玛丽直到六岁后才能流利地阅读。

He talks fluently about the subject at the meeting. 他在会议上畅谈这个问题。

【构词】fluent *adj.* 流利的,流畅的

He is fluent in two foreign languages. 他能流利地讲两种外语。

fluency *n.* 流利,流畅

To work as a translator, you need fluency in the foreign language. 要成为翻译,外语必须流畅。

13 governor

n.

1) 地方长官,州长

He was the governor of the province in the late 1990s. 在 20 世纪 90 年代末他曾是这个省的省长。

He was elected governor of the state of California. 他曾被选为加利福尼亚州的州长。

2) 主管,理事,董事

After the event, the prison governor resigned. 经过这一事件,典

Unit One

狱长辞了职。

The head teacher is appointed by the school governors. 首席教师是由学校理事会任命的。

Governors are using their powers to act against incompetent headmasters. 董事们运用手中的权力反对不能胜任的校长。

【构词】 govern *vt.* 统治, 治理, 管理

The country is governed by a small group of military officers. 这个国家由一小批军官统治。

government *n.* 政府

14 liberal

adj.

1) 赞成进步与改革的

Liberal legislators hoped to improve the fate of the poor. 赞成改革的立法人员希望改善穷人的命运。

We must try to keep a liberal attitude and listen to other sides. 我们必须有赞成改革的态度, 听取其他方面的意见。

2) 不要传统和准则等约束的, 开明的

The talks are aimed at liberal reform of our tax system. 几轮谈话, 主要就关于对税收制度进行开放性改革的问题而展开。

She is known to have liberal views on divorce. 据说她对离婚问题持有开明的观点。

15 needlework

n. 针线活, 缝纫手艺

She raised her tired eyes from doing needlework. 她从正在做的针线活中抬起她那双疲倦的眼睛。

He relaxed himself in chairs with needlework cushions. 他背着手工缝纫的靠垫上休息。



16 nobleman

n. 出身或地位高贵的人, 贵族

It is the club for the wealthy noblemen. 这是富人俱乐部。

The girl married a nobleman. 这女孩嫁给了贵族。

【构词】noble *adj.* 高贵的, 高尚的

It was very noble of you to look after your neighbor when he was sick. 邻居生病就照顾他, 你真好。

17 prominence

n. 显著, 杰出

This researcher is rising to prominence. 这个研究人员越来越出名。

He came to prominence during the World Cup in Italy. 在意大利举行的世界杯比赛中他一举成名。

【构词】prominent *adj.* 显著的, 杰出的

He is in a prominent position. 他地位显赫。

18 revolt

n.

1) 反叛, 起义

They seized the area in a revolt. 在反叛中他们占据了这座城市。

It was a revolt by ordinary people against the dictator. 这是一场老百姓反对独裁者的起义。

2) 反抗, 违抗

The whole nation is in a revolt against the cruel war. 全国人民都在奋起反抗残酷的战争。

They are in a revolt against the order of the armed forces. 他们违抗武装部队的命令。

vt. 使厌恶, 使生反感

Unit One

We were revolted by their indifference. 我们厌恶他们的漠然态度。

All wise people will revolt against the terrible crime. 所有明智的人都会对这个可怕的罪行反感。

vi. 反叛, 起义

The people revolted against the rotten officials. 人们起来反对腐败堕落的官员。

The peasants revolted against the king for he ordered to collect more taxes from them. 农民起来反对国王, 因为他下命令要征收更多的税。



19 effortlessly

adv. 毫不费力地, 轻易地

He finished the task effortlessly. 他毫不费力地完成了任务。

He can lift the heavy stone effortlessly. 他能轻易地搬起这块重石头。

【构词】effort *n.* 努力

It is quite an effort to lift his heavy box. 要费很大的力才能搬起那个重箱子。

effortless *adj.* 不费力的

He is a skillful and effortless performer on several musical instruments. 他能轻松自如地弹奏几种乐器。

20 essentially

adv. 本质上地, 实质上地

The teacher is essentially a very nice person. 这个老师实际上是个很好的人。

It was believed that great writers were essentially different from ordinary people. 人们相信, 伟大的作家在实质上与众不同。
