

## 前言

《决胜六级》丛书(2002 年最新修订本)是为即将参加六级考试的同学们准备的。我们希望,本套丛书能够尽量满足各种层次,尤其是基础差一些的同学们的需要,帮助他们尽量节省宝贵的时间,尽快熟悉六级考试的形式和内容,争取一举通过六级考试。

#### 本书具有以下四大特点:

- 一、"全",模拟形式全。根据国家教委公布的《大学英;语号试大纲》、《样题》和大学英语六级考试题型,本书设计了六级考试可能使用到的各种模拟题型,全面反映了《教学大纲》和《考纲》的宗旨和要求。听力部分增加了 Compound Dictation。为了提高考生的动手能力,还设计了英汉互译的题型。写作部分给出了有关目前社会热点问题的作文题和参考样文。
- 二、"真"。本书以选择"真题"为出发点,力求使每道试题的容量和难易度都和实际考试题一致,而且,材料大多选自最新英、美书刊,语言规范,表达生动准确,集文学、历史、文化、风土人情、传记、科技为一体,兼顾趣味性与科学性,把大学英语六级考试五大部分的特点展现在考生面前,使他们能把握住特点,轻松逾越考试大关。
- 三、"细"。本书对考题进行了精心细致的研究与分析,并给出尽可能详尽、准确的解答,使考生对考题不仅知其然,而且知其所以然;不仅学到了知识,而且学会了分析问题、解决问题的方法。

四、"准"。本书的指导方向准。无论从选材、题型的编排,还是从

问题的解答上看,本书都是以培养和提高考生的语言综合运用能力、实践能力为出发点的。我们相信,只要考生能按照《大纲》和《考纲》的要求,认真模拟训练本书的试题,一定会取得成功!
