

瞧! 英语中就是有这么多生动的词组或短语,乍一看似乎谁都明白,可是这种"想当然"的猜测全都不对。这是英语的魅力所在,但同时词汇量和英语的灵活性也是学习英语的两大难关。本书旨在帮助读者攻克这两个难关。

无论是大中学生,还是其他英语学习者,都已经积累了一定数量的英语单词。本书的目的就在于充分利用这个现有条件,帮助读者在无须增加新单词的前提下,科学地、大幅度地扩充词汇量,全面提高阅读能力和表达能力,以使原先掌握的英语单词和基础知识得到以一当十的发挥和运用,快速、准确地拓展英语视野。

学习者在阅读时,最感困惑的是英语的灵活性。如何理解

变幻莫测的英语含义?如何把英语学活?如何学到地道的英语?这是摆在每个学习者面前相当重要和棘手的问题。而英语的这种变化多端的灵活性究竟蕴藏在哪里呢?不仅在复杂的单词定义里、在语法条文中,更在普通词汇的奇妙组合中。日常生活中最基本的单词,如食品中的 bread、cake, 或颜色中的 green、white,或物品中的 ball、book等,一旦和另一些同样简单的单词组合,便会产生意思迥然不同、涵义千变万化的词组或短语。

本书精选的词条都来自多彩鲜活的英语世界,不但妙趣横生,而且非常实用。通过直接触模到其灵活性,读者将系统地发现、理解、掌握它们组合的规律,使学到的英语活起来、地道起来。

善于学习英语的人,除下工夫外,还必须掌握合理的学习方法。本书的编排完全符合读者心理,讲究循循善诱,一经点拨,便会过目不忘。其中:

原来如此通过"去伪存真"板块帮助读者识破词条的字面假象,从而牢记其真正涵义;"原汁原味"板块给出了词条的英语解释;"触类旁通"板块列出了词条的近义词;"举一反三"板块列举了与词条相关的搭配;"造句指南"板块为读者提供了例句。

再来试试列出若干词条,可使读者进一步操练,并扩充词汇量,从而增强学习效果。

西洋號介绍了大量趣味性很强的英语知识,从文化、历史、宗教,到文学、体育,涵盖了英语世界的各个层面。
