前 言

托福考试中的第三部分——"阅读理解及词汇"部分中的词汇试题共30道,阅读理解试题30道,各占据了该部分总分的一半(阅读理解试题中的词汇出现在本套书的下册),就词汇试题而言,考生若选错了一个词,即失去一个原始分。可见"词汇"是影响这部分得分的关键。因此,托福考试词汇试题的"范围",历来是广大考生及英语教学工作者最为关注的问题之一。本书旨在帮助考生在较短的时间内最有效地掌握"托福"词汇,以期在第三部分获得最佳成绩,并由此而提高第一、二部分的得分。

在本书中,编者收集了 1976 年~1992 年共 15 年的 63 套全真托福词汇试题,以及在此期间所考的近 2000 个托福单词。在此基础上,本书对历年来托福考试中词汇部分所考过的全部单词和短语以及多项选择中的全部词汇进行了全面系统的总结,对词汇部分中出现的词(即试题中的划线单词及其同义或近义替换词)按不同的词性进行分类、详解,按词意总结出其相应的同义词和反义词,总词汇量超过 1 万。同时举例示明其用法,使之达到举一反三的效果。本书附有历年托福词汇全真试题,以便于考生进行练习,并巩固前面所学的词汇。

词汇是托福考试中的基础和关键,倘若我们对托福词汇的特点及其规律有充分的了解,即是找到了一条有效掌握托福词汇的捷径。本书对托福词汇的规律进行了系统的总结,其主要特点可概述为;

- 一、在全书汇集的近 2000 个单词中,90%以上的词均属 "共核"(Common Core)词,即属于基本词汇的范畴。同样, 每个单词的替换词及其同义词也均属这一类词汇。
- 二、从这近 2000 个已考过的单词的词法及其句法来看,它们主要由名词、动词和形容词,即"实词"构成。其中一个值得重视的规律是:在这三类词中,每类的数量大约各占总数的 1/3,并分别按这个比例分布于每套词汇试题之中。另外,有少数单词是以一ly 结尾的副词,它们都是由形容词(词干)派生而成,因此本书将该部分副词按形容词性归类。余下的 70 几个单词或短语属于其他词类,数量极少,不具有代表性,我们将这类词汇全部归入一大类——杂词类。

三、托福考试词汇试题中的有些词,在历届试题中其重复出现的频率是很高的。许多词曾出现过二或三次,最多的已达到六次。为了表明这一现象,我们将全部原题按先后次序编号,再将每一个编号标注于《词汇详解部分》中每个词条之后,若一个词在四套考题中分别出现过,则该词就有四个编号。这样可根据编号个数对该词在原题中的重复出现率一目了然。

我们希望,通过本书,能使读者站在一个更高的境界,纵览"森林"的全貌,在茫茫的英语词林中有的放矢地探奇觅胜,使读者克服那种"只见树木,不见森林"、就题论题的片面学习方法。

最后, 诚**望各**位同行及广大读者对本书中的缺点和不妥 之处批评指正。另外, 在编写本书的过程中得到了很多同事 和朋友的热情关心和无私帮助, 在此, 谨向他们表示最衷心 的感谢!

内容提要

《历届全真托福词汇总览》分为上、下两册,上册针对托福考试第三部分的前 30 道词汇试题。下册针对该部分的后 30 道阅读理解试题中的词汇。

本书为上册,共两大部分。第一部分系统地总结了历届托福词汇试题中所考的词,这些词按不同的词性分成 4 大类。每个词有详解,同义词或反义词,例句,编号。根据编号,读者可以在第二部分真题中找到出处。第二部分汇集了历届托福全真词汇试题近 2000 道,有答案,真题按考试的先后顺序统一编号,以便读者在使用第一部分时查阅。

两大部分既相互联系,又自成体系,各具特色。读者既可以分别使用,各取所需,又可以将两部分联系起来使用。
