## 前 言

语言是社会生活中人们进行信息传递、思想交流、情感表达的工具。学习外语,就是为了扩大中外交流,互递信息,了解外国的文化,学习外国的先进科学技术和经验。

英语是我国中学生必须学习、掌握的一门工具性学科。学习、掌握英语离不开两条,一是语言知识,二是实践训练。语言知识是英语学习的基础,但是,英语学习的最终目的是把英语变成日常生活中的交际工具,使之成为人生斗争的有用武器。因此学习英语既要克服"哑巴英语"、"聋子英语"、也要防止"瞎子英语"和"半文盲英语"。《中学生英语学习系列丛书》突出语言知识与实践训练为一体。内容涉及英语词汇、语法、阅读、完形填空、听力、会话、翻译与写作等各个方面。

《英语语法能力突破(高中卷)》一书含有 21 套语法测试卷。 每套测试卷均由 80 道多项选择题、10 道改错题和 10 道动词填空 题组成。习题均经过精选,其中相当一部分题目选自近年高考英 语全国卷,有关省市的高考英语试卷及高中英语竞赛试卷。内容 兼顾全国及有关省市的不同教材。习题具有较强的代表性和规范 性,覆盖语法知识点也比较全面。

本书 适用于高中学生,三校生及相当程度的英语自学者使用。为便于读者自测,书后附有全部测试题的答案。

本书由上海市大同中学尹福昌老师主编,参加编写的还有该书编写组其他成员。

由于编者水平有限,书中疏漏之处难免,敬请广大读者指正。
