

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
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本书是第一本用中英文对照书写的针刺手法技术图解。内容共分 六章。第一章针刺基础,介绍从持针、得气到出针的常识;第二章毫 针刺法,亦为本书的重点,主要介绍了针刺前后10余种辅助手法,20 多种行针辅助手法,常用8种补泻法和20种复式针刺手法及多种其他 针法等;第三章《内经》论刺法,重点介绍了"九刺"、"十二刺"、"五 刺"、"三刺"、导气等20余种方法;第四章透穴针术,介绍了比较特 殊的透穴术近30种;第五章艺术针法,介绍了临床行之有效的常用 艺术针术23种;第六章特种针刺法、介绍了11种特种针法和针术。 全书内容丰富,体现了针刺技术的重要性和必要性。

Diagrams of Acupuncture Manipulations, a first Chinese–English book on the manipulations of needles, is divided into six chapters. Chapter 1, Essentials of Acupuncture, introduces the general knowledge of holding the needle, obtaining acuesthesia and withdrawing the needle. Chapter 2, Needling Techniques of the Filiform Needle, the core of this book, introduces over 10 kinds of supplementary techniques used before and after needling, over 20 kinds of supplementary needling techniques, 8 kinds of general strengthening and reducing techniques, about 20 kinds of complex needling techniques and other needling techniques. Chapter 3, Needling Techniques in Neijing, mainly introduces Nine Needling Techniques, Twelve Needling Techniques, Five Needling Techniques, Three Needling

techniques, Qi Directing etc. Chapter 4, Penetrated Needling, introduces about 30 kinds of special penetrated needling techniques. Chapter 5, Artistic Needling, introduces 23 kinds of artistic needling techniques effective in clinical use. Chapter 6, Special Needling Techniques, introduces 11 kinds of special needling techniques.

This book is rich in content, demonstrating the importance and necessity of the needling techniques.

刘炎、性别男、出生于1941年6月、民族汉、上海松江人。大学本科(6年制)毕业。上海中医药大学教授、针灸推拿学院院长、中华全国高等中医院校针灸教育研究会会长、上海市中医药学会中医综合疗法研究会会长、中国针灸学会刺灸分会副理事长。

Recently, he also takes part in seven research projects of state and bureau level, such as "Clinical and Mechanism Study on Drug Abuse Treated by Acupuncture and Herbal Preparation" and "Experimental Study on Methodology of Transdermal Absorption of 'Salvia and Astragalus Heart-Benefiting Plaster'". The treatment of acupuncture depends on various manipulative techniques to exert effect. Since verbal description alone is difficult to explain it clearly, figures and illustrations are often required. Early in the Chapter of Nine Needles and Twelve Yuan-Primary Acupoints in Lingshu, it is suggested that "the shape has to be divided respectively and the Canon of Acupuncture must be established first", indicating that the illustration of the manipulative techniques of acupuncture is very important. However in the ancient books, the figures were only confined to the shape of the needles and the structure of the human body which were poorly drawn and were only improved in the

modern times. Besides, the description of the manipulative techniques in the previous books was both fragmentary and unsystematic. Professor Liu Yan has made great efforts to collect the materials concerned and classified them into several types with brief description and clear illustration for the benefit of international readers. Li Zhaoguo is invited to translate it into English. This Chinese–English description and illustration of the manipulative techniques of acupuncture is undoubtedly helpful for readers both at home and abroad. That is why I have written this note to recommend it to the readers.

### Introduction

Acumox(acupuncture and moxibustion) is an indispensable part of traditional Chinese medicine and has made great contribution to the development and prosperity of the Chinese nation. With the development of TCM, acumox not only has spread all over China, but also become internationally popular. However many international acupuncturists only know some primary knowledge about acumox, but are unfamiliar with the excellent skills and effective needling techniques at the higher level. In medical practice, proficiency in needling decides the curative effect. Therefore how to correctly and efficiently study the needling skills and techniques is key to the mastery of acumox and the improvement of the curative effect of acumox.

In our university there are many international students, most of whom specialize in acumox. Some of them even have studied in our university for 3 or 5 times, just for the improvement of their needling skills. They have read many books but still cannot grasp the gist of the manipulative techniques because there are no books devoted to simple and systematic explanation of the manipulative techniques. To meet this need, ! have compiled this book based on my personal experience in the past 35 years and the practice of other teachers, doctors and researchers. This Chinese–English book is mainly devoted to the techniques and methods of acupuncture for readers inside and outside China.

There may be some errors in this compilation. The counterparts both inside and outside China are welcome to point them out so that they can be corrected in the next revision.
