前音

選本「中英對照名人語錄」,可以說是本局 华年前出版的「英語格言菁華」的姊妹篇,甚至 可以算是續集。然而,在編選的原則方面,這一 本和前一本又有多少不同。

首先, 「英語格言菁華」所選的多是所 間 「格言家」筆下的東西, 還些格言家, 是有意識 地整理和編寫格言的。而「中英對照名人語錄」 所選的, 則多是從作家、思想家、科學家、哲人 等等的作品中、論文中, 摘下來的糖采的短句。

其次,「格言」和「語錄」的含義也稍有不同。「格言」一般指對人們的思想、行為具有一定指導作用的文字;而「語錄」的範閱較廣,凡經錄下來的嘉語,往往對人們的思想、行為只起啓發作用,它可能會使它的讀者聯想起許多不是一本書所能包含的問題,但離要是拿着它來代替自己對生活的分析、判斷,就難免有時會產生認課。

世界上名人的嘉語與是多如恆河沙數,本會所選擇的實在只是九牛一毛吧了。如果讀者能從 這本小冊子中得到一點益處的話,當然我們還會 繼續編譯出版這一類書的。
