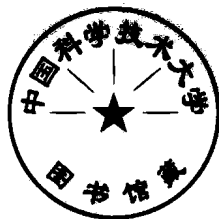

内 容 提 要

王守廉、李秀芹教授主编的《大学英语学习系列丛书》是一套英语系列工具书。本丛书包括6个分册：《大学英语语法要点精编》、《大学英语动词用法精编》、《大学英语连词用法精编》、《大学英语介词用法精编》、《大学英语短语用法精编》及《大学英语词语辨析精编》。

本丛书是依据原国家教委制定的《大学英语教学大纲》的精神编写的，旨在供各类院校的大学生、研究生及有同等英语水平的人自学使用，也可供大中专英语教师教学参考。

《大学英语短语用法精编》是《大学英语学习系列丛书》之一。全书共收各类短语1 669条。对每一条短语都加以汉语释义，并对每个义项一般附3个例句。释义力求准确、简明；例句力求语言规范、浅显实用；译文力求准确流畅。

为了便于读者查阅，本书在正文前编有“使用说明”，在正文后编有“索引”。

前 言

《大学英语短语用法精编》(A Chosen Compilation of Usage of College English Idioms and Phrases)是王守廉、李秀芹教授主编的《大学英语学习系列丛书》之一,供大学生、研究生及具有同等英语水平的人自修使用,也可供大中专院校英语教师教学参考。

本书是依据原国家教委制定的《大学英语教学大纲》编写的。全书共收短语 1 669 条,其中包括动词短语、介词短语、名词短语、形容词短语及副词短语。

为了便于查阅,本书正文前编有“使用说明”,在正文后编有“索引”。

如何正确理解和灵活使用短语是学生学习英语的主要困难之一,也是教师讲授英语的主要任务之一。因此,本书在处理释义及其例证时,力求兼顾理解和使用两个方面。本书的主要特色是:义项较全,释义准确,例证充分。每个义项一般附 3 个例句。例句语言规范,力求浅显、实用。例句选自现代英、美词典、书报杂志及原国家教委推出的现行大学英语教材。每一例句都附有汉译。译文力求准确流畅。

由于时间仓促,书中错误和不妥之处,欢迎读者指正。

使用说明

一、《大学英语短语用法精编》所收短语词条按英语 26 个字母顺序排列，查阅时与使用英文字典的方法相同。

二、词条有不同或多种释义时，前面标有 1、2、3……字码。意义大体相同的释义在同一义项内；释义有别用分号隔开。

三、词条中不同词类的短语有不同的表示方法：

1. 动词短语，短语居首，其后用逗号与不定式符号 to 隔开，如 bring about, to; catch up with, to。如果一个动词可组成多个短语，其后的介词或副词按 26 个字母顺序出现，如 break away, break back, break down。

2. 动词短语表示动作及于客体时用 sb., sth.；表示动作返回主体时用 one, one's, oneself。上述代词作为词条的一部分排列出来，如 do sb. a favour (帮助某人)；help oneself to sth. (自由取食进餐)。

3. 只能作表语的短语，其后用逗号与 to be 隔开，如 interested in, to be; bound for, to be。

4. 以冠词开头的名词性短语将定冠词放在短语之后用逗号隔开，如 apple of one's eye, the；以不定冠词开头的某些短语属不可拆开之列，保持其原样，如 a lot of, a number of。

四、其它符号的用法：

1. / 表示其前后的动词、介词或副词组成的短语意义相同，如 get/catch hold of; look down on/upon。

2. () 表示其内的词可用可不用，如 cut down (on)。

3. → 表示参见某一词条并且不再写出汉语释义和例句，如 come about → bring about。
