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前 言

英语考试成败的关键因素之一是词汇，MPA 考试也是如此。为了帮助参加 MPA 考试的广大考生有效地突破词汇大关，以便为听、说、读、写、译打下坚实的基础，我们针对 MPA 考生群体的特点，结合多年英语教学和测试的实践经验，编写了这本《MPA 联考英语单词随身听》。本书有以下特点：

1. 严格按照国务院学位委员会办公室、教育部研究生工作办公室、人事部公务员管理司组织编写的《公共管理硕士（MPA）专业学位联考考试大纲及考试指南》编写，共收入词汇 4 000 个左右（包括约 10% 的常用专业词汇），常用词组 600 个左右。

2. 考虑到绝大多数 MPA 考生毕业离校多年，英语不同程度地被淡忘这一特点，本手册不但按每个单词给定的义项给出了例句，而且配有中文译文，便于考生在一定语境中深刻理解并掌握每个单词和词组的确切含义和用法，以及与中文表达上的异同，进而达到不仅记住而且会用的目的。

3. 根据听觉记忆在语言学习中的重要作用，我们对每个单词、词组配制了美国专家的录音，考生可以通过听觉这一接受信息的方式，在大脑中输入有声语言，同时联想词形、词义，做到音、形、义结合，从而达到强化记忆的目的。

总之，我们希望考生通过听单词录音、模仿跟读、阅读例句、体会译文、应用写作等步骤的同时进行，达到尽快越过词汇难关，顺利通过考试这一目的。

参加本书编写的还有赵艳清、张兴雁、王玥鑫同志。由于编写时间短，编者水平所限，书中疏漏和错误在所难免，敬请广大同仁和读者提出宝贵意见。

abandon

v. 放弃，抛弃 In his early days, he abandoned medicine for literature. 他早年弃医从文。

abide

v. 遵守，坚持 As a student, you should abide by the discipline. 作为一名学生，你应该遵守纪律。

ability

n. 能力，智能，才能 I do not doubt your ability to do the work. 我不怀疑你有能力担任这项工作。
