本书是根据由教育部考试中心开发的全国公共英语等级考试(PETS)第四级(Level 4)考试大纲及考试要求编写的一套英语听力考试强化训练教材。PETS 第四级考试是面向社会的、开放的、非学历性的英语等级考试。其试题与评分标准是以考察考生交际能力为核心,考生不受职业、年龄和学历背景等方面限制,其级别标准相当于我国学生普通高中毕业后在大学至少又学习了 3——4年的公共英语或自学了同等程度英语课程的水平。通过该级考试的考生,其英语水平基本满足攻读高等院校非英语专业硕士研究生的需要,基本符合一般专业技术人员和研究人员、现代企业经理等工作对英语的要求。

根据大纲中关于四级考试听力部分的要求,考生应"能够听懂英文讲座,学术发言或论证的大部分内容"。此教材立足大纲要求,结合多年教学经验,综合了各方面意见,对收集到的大量听力材料进行了整理和修改,选材新,题材广泛,为考生提供了大量针对 PETS 第四级考试的材料和练习,考生使用起来如同身临其境,必将帮助考生有效地提高听力应试水平。

PETS 第四级考试的听力部分所需时间约为 30 分钟(含誊写和转涂答案的时间), 试卷内容由 A、B、C 节组成,考察考生理解英语口语的能力。考试大纲要求:

"A节(5题):考察考生理解具体信息的能力。要求考生根据所听到的一段 180—220 词的独白或对话的内容,填补句子或表格中的空白。录音材料播放两遍。

B节(5 题): 考察考生理解总体和特定信息的能力。要求考生根据所听到的一段 280——320 词的独白或对话,回答 5 道简答题。录音材料播放两遍。

C节(10 题): 考察考生获取特定信息,理解主旨要义和详细信息,猜测词义,判断演讲者态度、意图的能力。要求考生根据所听到的三段独白或对话(每段 200—300 词),从每题所给的各选择项中选出最佳选项。每段录音材料只播放一遍。"

为了使考生进行有针对性的练习,更好地掌握 A、B、C 节的不同要求,本教材也按 A 节、B 节、C 节三部分编排,每部分包括十套该节的练习材料,其题型与 PETS 第四级考试的题型完全一致。在练习答案中附有解析部分,简明扼要地讲解了答案的由来。教材中附有录音内容的全部文字材料,在每段文字材料后附有简明的单词和短语注释。文字材料部分由外籍教师以标准音朗读,由专业录音师以专业录音器材录制。

●本书使用特色

- 1. 你可以集中做 A、B、C 各节的练习,这样可以熟练掌握每一节的题型和答题技巧。也可以把 A、B、C 节拆开使用,如先做 A 节中的第一套题,再做 B 节中的第一套题,最后做 C 节中的第一套题,这样就可以凑成一整套听力考题进行训练。
- 2. 每做完一套练习,可以停下录音机,翻到答案及解析部分检查一下你所做的答案。一定要在做完这部分练习后再参看录音的文字材料及注释。
- 3. 录音磁带上的内容完全参照正式考试的时间要求及格式录制,包括指令、听力材料、问题及 指令上所要求的停顿时间。所以在使用这套教材时只要打开录音机,跟着你所做的那套练 习的录音进行就可以了。

●本书答题技巧

- 1. 因为 A、B、C 三节的题型不同,在做练习时一定要熟悉这三种题型的要求和应答方法:
 - A 节要求填补空白,而且所填字数一般不超过三个单词;
 - B 节要求做简答题,而且答案字数一般不超过五个单词;
 - C 节要求选出最佳选项;

你所做的答案字数一定不能超过要求的字数,单词拼写及语法要尽量正确。A、B 节的答案不用写成完整的句子,只需按要求写出记录式的单词或短语(notes)、字母或数字。数字一般写成阿拉伯数字即可。可以先把答案写在试卷上,因为在听力试题做完后有五分钟誊写答案的时间。

- 2. 要有目的地去听。你的目的就是弄明白该问题要求你做什么,快速找到有关资料并作出准确的答案。因此如果有听不懂的个别单词也不必过于担心。
- 3. 为了做到有目的地听,就要充分利用播放所听段落之前的准备时间。首先,每节考试内容之前都有"指令"部分。这些指令内容印在试卷上,而且一般都包含关于所听材料的摘要或简短提示,要认真读或听这一部分。"指令"之后会有一段短暂的时间留给你,让你先读一下随后的答题内容。A 节留出 25 秒,B 节留出 25 秒,C 节在每篇文章之前都留出 15 秒(若有三道问题)或 20 秒(若有四道问题)。一定要充分利用这些时间,纵揽随后的问题。这样你就可以对将要听到的材料做到心中有数,预料到将要听到有关什么的内容,以及要回答哪方面的问题(如:时间,人名,原因等),因此,在听的过程中就可以做到有的放矢,着重听与所问问题相关的关键信息,有效提高听力能力。
- 4. 在听每篇文章时,不要只注意你所听到的各个单词,而是要着重听你需要找的关键信息。一边听,一边把答案快速写下来,写的时候耳朵还要继续听朗读的内容。如果你在前一步的准备工作做好了,即提前分析出你将听到什么内容以及找哪方面的答案,这一步就不会太难了。如果有必要,可适当作些笔记(尤其是在做 C 节练习时),快速简短地记录相关的具体信息,如时间等,但不能影响听随后的内容。
- 5. 因为 A、B 两节每篇文章的朗读都播放两遍, 你就要根据自己的情况或习惯, 充分利用第二 遍放音的机会。你可以把第二遍放音作为验证或检查所做答案的机会, 检查你的答案是否 正确, 是否符合指令的要求。也可以利用第二遍放音, 把在第一遍放音中没作出的题再着 重听一遍。
- 6. C 节录音只放一遍,但在每篇文章朗读完之后,你都会被告知有 30 秒(若有三道问题)或 40 秒(若有四道问题)的时间来检查答案。要充分利用这一段时间来检查答案。
- 7. 在正式考试中,当全部听力考试试题进行完之后,你将被告知有五分钟的时间将所有听力 答案转抄到答题纸上。要快速准确地做完这一工作,若有时间可再一次检查听力部分的答案。
