Thank you for your letter. Ms. Rieck and Mrs. McKinney enjoyed immensely their visit to your English Center in Taipei.


I appreciated receiving the report on the possibilities of the center. I think you have a bright future.


Dear Tim:



 - ⑥美國大學及學院入學標準等書籍。使用上列這些參考書，編成本書，其內容如下：
- 1 如何選擇美國大學及學院。
 - 2 如何申請入學證明及獎學金，
 - 3 美國五十州及其他地區簡介。
 - 4 美國五十州及其他地區教育概況，
 - 5 教育部認可及根據美國教育評審會發表之美國各大學及獨立學院詳解。

本書編彙之目的是為一般準備赴美留學的青年在出國前對於欲申請之美國各大學及獨立之學院，及各該校特點有明確的認識及瞭解，同時亦能使讀者，估計本身之經濟能力，是否能負擔你欲進入之學校所需要之費用，同時亦可使你瞭解各校可獲得獎學金之情況，這樣才不致因隨便申請而誤進了一個學校。到達美國後，因學校不適合自己志趣。甚至因不能負擔學校之昂貴學費，又用盡了所帶去的錢，而流落海外，則更為可惜了。

爲了節省讀者之費用，編者特在各校注明入學所須之考試：例如 TOEFL（外國學生之英文能力考試）及 G. R. E (Graduate Record Examination 研究生入學資格考試) 作爲讀者欲申請學校時之參考，而且編者又將本書使用之中英文系別列對照表，作爲讀者選擇科系時之參考。

本書在編輯期間，聘請了多位留美學者協助編輯及翻譯，全部耗費已超過新臺幣二十餘萬元，足見本書所具之價值及編者對本書編輯期間之嚴謹態度。若仍有謬誤疏漏之處，尚祈先進明達及讀者們不吝賜教匡正，則幸甚矣！
