内容提要

本书为教学测试题集,内容与课文密切相关,形式以主观题为主,客观题为辅,或与课文练习形式交叉,采用一课一试,每五课一次阶段性测试的方式,以便配合 21 世纪大学英语教学,同时也使学生能够复习和消化自己所学的课文内容,得到一次综合性训练。

全书的测试范围以读写教程中 Text A 为主,兼顾 Text B 和Text C 以及练习册等有关内容。主观题包含少量翻译、回答问题和作文,另外大部分为填空题,教师可根据教学需要任意选用,学生也可随意选做。

前 言

本书为教学测试题集,采用一课一试、每五课一次阶段测试的方式,目的是为了密切配合《21世纪大学英语》教程的教学,帮助教师深入了解学生每课或每阶段的学习情况,同时使学生每学完一课获得一次测试,既可以了解自己的学习状况,又能复习消化刚学过的内容,得到一次综合性训练。

本书测试内容与课文密切相关,形式以主观题为主,客观题为辅,或与课文上的练习形式交叉。主观题中除了少量翻译、回答问题和作文外(批改比较费时),大部分均为填空题(以减少教师的阅卷时间)。测试范围以读写教程中 Text A 为主,兼顾 Text B和 Text C、听说教程第三/四部分(第三册为二/三部分)、和练习册上有关的内容。听力选自读写教程 Text A 现有的预听材料和听说教程第三/四部分的听力音带中的内容,没有另行制作,以减少教师的麻烦,节省学生开支。除听力以外,还有词汇、结构、阅读理解、翻译和写作部分。每份测试都附有对应的答题纸和参考答案,测试时间控制在一个学时内,如课时较紧,教师也可把试卷的某一部分作为随堂小测验或练习使用。

全套书共有四册,本书为《21世纪大学英语》教学测试第一册,部分试题已经过上海大学 2000级近 5,000名学生试用一年,取得了较好的效果,受到教师和学生的欢迎。全书根据广大师生的意见作了进一步修改和补充。

Many students visit Britain every summer either as $\underline{71}$, or to learn the language, or to a $\underline{72}$ of the two. If you are thinking of visiting Britain, there are a few things that you should be ready for.

First, the weather can be very <u>73</u>—even in summer—so you never know what it's going to be like. It might be <u>74</u> or sunny, hot or cold, so you should be prepared for everything and take some summer clothes and warmer ones.

Secondly, opening hours for shops, $\underline{75}$, etc. can be very different from other countries. Shops $\underline{76}$ open at 9 a. m. and close at 3:30 p. m., with no $\underline{77}$ in the middle of the day. As for pubs, their opening hours $\underline{78}$. Normally hours are 11:30 a. m. to 2:30 p. m., 5:30 p. m. to $\underline{79}$, but you may find some pubs are open longer than this. You will also find discotheques open quite late, that generally speaking, $\underline{80}$ finishes early in Britain and so does public $\underline{81}$.

Finally, if you want to eat out, there are lots of 82, but they tend to be expensive unless they are 83 or Chinese. The food in these is generally 84 and good value for money. Food in pubs is often good, varied and cheap. If you are under 18, they won't let you drink 85 with your meal.
