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内 容 提 要

本书为教学测试题集,内容与课文密切相关,形式以主观题为主,客观题为辅,或与课文练习形式交叉,采用一课一试,每五课一次阶段性测试的方式,以便配合 21 世纪大学英语教学,同时也使学生能够复习和消化自己所学的课文内容,得到一次综合性训练。

全书的测试范围以读写教程中 Text A 为主,兼顾 Text B 和 Text C 以及练习册等有关内容。主观题包含少量翻译、回答问题和作文,另外大部分为填空题,教师可根据教学需要任意选用,学生也可随意选做。

前 言

本书为教学测试题集,采用一课一试、每五课一次阶段测试的方式,目的是为了密切配合《21 世纪大学英语》教程的教学,帮助教师深入了解学生每课或每阶段的学习情况,同时使学生每学完一课获得一次测试,既可以了解自己的学习状况,又能复习消化刚学过的内容,得到一次综合性训练。

本书测试内容与课文密切相关,形式以主观题为主,客观题为辅,或与课文上的练习形式交叉。主观题中除了少量翻译、回答问题和作文外(批改比较费时),大部分均为填空题(以减少教师的阅卷时间)。测试范围以读写教程中 Text A 为主,兼顾 Text B 和 Text C、听说教程第三/四部分(第三册为二/三部分)、和练习册上有关的内容。听力选自读写教程 Text A 现有的预听材料和听说教程第三/四部分的听力音带中的内容,没有另行制作,以减少教师的麻烦,节省学生开支。除听力以外,还有词汇、结构、阅读理解、翻译和写作部分。每份测试都附有对应的答题纸和参考答案,测试时间控制在一个学时内,如课时较紧,教师也可把试卷的某一部分作为随堂小测验或练习使用。

全套书共有四册,本书为《21 世纪大学英语》教学测试第一册,部分试题已经过上海大学 2000 级近 5,000 名学生试用一年,取得了较好的效果,受到教师 and 学生的欢迎。全书根据广大师生的意见作了进一步修改和补充。
