




TOEFL考试于 1995 年 8 月改变了考试题型,现在的考试由四大部分组成,它们分别是:作文(Test of Written English)、听力(Listening Comprehension)、语法(Structure and Written Expression)和阅读(Reading Comprehension)。在我看来,在这四部分中,如果不具备一定的词汇量,要在听力和语法部分中拿高分尚有可能,但是要想在阅读和作文部分中取得优异成绩,则必须要有丰富的词汇基础。

自任新东方 TOEFL 教师以来,我听到学员最多的抱怨就是 TOEFL 词汇不知道如何去准备,不知道准备哪些词汇最具有针对性,于是我有了一个想法,就是希望给广大学员在准备词汇方面力所能及地提供一些帮助,让他们在准备出国留学的过程中尽量少走一些弯路,这也是我编写此书的最终目的。

### 本书具有如下特点:


- 1. 书中所选词组是 1989 年以后 TOEFL 历年考试阅读理解文章中出现的核心词组,掌握了这些词组,也就基本上解决了 TOEFL 考试所需词组,对将要参加 TOEFL 考试的考生具有很强的应试指导作用。
- 2. 每个词组后面都附有例句,例句的难度和句子结构复杂程度上和真题考试阅读理解文章中的句子一致,并附有中文翻译。掌握这些例句,不仅有助于大家记忆、理解词组的精确含义,而且对理解 TOEFL 阅读文章大有裨益。这也是本书区别于其他 TOEFL 词组书的最大特点。
- 3. 其中带 "\*"号的词组为 1989 年以后历年 TOEFL 考试阅读理解 部分中单独考过的词组题。
- 4. 为帮助大家进一步扩大词汇量,使大家为以后的 GRE、GMAT、LSAT 等考试做准备,本书将所有重要词组都列出了同义词或参考词汇。



时间仓促,草成此书,其中不免有失误和遗漏之处,希望广大学员和读者不吝指正。希望此书对准备 TOEFL 考试的读者有一些帮助,也希望准备或正在准备参加 TOEFL 考试的考生取得自己期望的好成绩!


