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出版说明

高等教育自学考试是国家规定的学历考试,也是个人自学、社会助学和国家考试相结合的一种新的教育形式。实践证明,高等教育自学考试制度是一项调动广大群众学习积极性,促进自学成才,造就和选拔人才的有效途径之一,因而受到了社会的普遍欢迎。高等教育自学考试已经成为我国社会主义高等教育体系的一个重要组成部分。

英语专业自学考试是各地普遍开考的专业之一,至一九八五年底,全国已有二十一个省市开考英语专业。参加过英语自学考试的人数达三万五千人,已有专科毕业生四百四十二人。在全国高等教育自学考试指导委员会领导下,英语专业委员会在一九八五年六月召开了第一次全体会议,制定了英语专业考试计划,今后各省市的英语专业自学考试都将参照此计划进行。

上海是最早试行高等教育自学考试制度的省市之一。上海外国语学院主考的英语专业(本、专科)是首批公布开考的专业之一,自一九八二年十一月首次考试以来,已举行了七次考试,包括该专业的所有课程,

为了使有志参加英语专业高等教育自学考试的考生和助学单位比较全面地了解本专业各门课程考试的要求、内容、范围、形式以及应达到的实际运用语言的能力,我们把上海外国语学院英语专业开考以来的试题和参考答案按课程汇编成册,公开出版。本专业的公共课程试题前已汇编出版,故不再列入。本科阶段的第二外语课程,因语种较多也未列入本书。本

书有助于考生更好地安排学习计划,改进学习方法,提高自学效果,对高等院校的英语专业师生和广大英语自学者也有一定的参考价值。读者可以此自归本人的英语水平。

高等教育自学考试命题是一项新的工作。我们和主考高校虽然组织有丰富教学经验和责任感强的教师担任命题工作、努力掌握好各门课程自学考试大纲的要求和考试标准。但由于缺乏经验,难免还有不够妥善之处。我们将不断探索,研究改进命题工作,并逐步建立英语专业课程的试题题库,力求做到考试标准化。

目前 全国绝大多数省市开展了高等教育自学考试,全国高等教育委员会也将成立考试研究专业委员会,我们把本书奉献出来,希望通过共同的研究与交流,把自学考试工作做得更好。

本书由于编排时间**勿**促, 难免有疏漏不当之处, 敬希广大 读者指正。
