前言

随着我们与国外的交流日益频繁,尽快提高我国大学生的英语口语水平已成为大家的共识。教育部对此非常重视。高等教育司专门在200)年下发有关文件,要求全国有条件的城市全面实施大学英语四、六级口语考试,以促进大学英语口语教学的发展。为了适应形势发展的需要,帮助大学生提高英语口语水平并且在考试中取得好成绩,我们精心编写了这本口语教程。

本书在编写过程中遵循了以下几个原则:

一、内容涵盖《大学英语教学大纲》特别是《大学英语口语考试大纲》所列举的重要为功能意念项目。这里"重要"的意思是指学生或考生们在叙述、描绘、说明和辩论时常用的语言表达功能项目。本书第一章共收入50个功能项目,每个项目里有两组对话供同学们模仿、操练。对话中所出现的语言功能、意念的表述形式均用粗体标出以引起同学们的注意。在Communicative Function 部分里同学们还要就这一项目进行强化训练,要根据所提供的情节和前面的对话模式组织对话,熟悉、掌握各种用法。

二、强调英语口语学习是一个过程。学生在语篇的层次上进行表达之前必须有一个准备(warm-up)过程,否则同学们就会觉得无话可说,逐渐失去学习口语的兴趣。为此我们在第二章精心设计了以下程序: Step 1. Useful Words and Expressions 学生们首先熟悉与所谈话题有关的词语。 Step 2. Check the new words and expressions in your dictionary and write one sentence for each word or expression. 学生在熟悉有关词语的基础上进行造句水平的操练。 Step 3. Think of things to say. 学生们通过看图表、图片、照片和文字提示整理思路,并与同伴讨论,然后进行口头表达。 Step 4. Record your presentation on a tape-

recorder. Correct your own errors. Keep practicing until you feel confident that you can talk about this topic freely. 这一部分的意图为增强学生学习的自主性,让学生通过录音对自己的口语水平进行评估,发现问题,解决问题。在最后的 Reference Answer 部分学生可参照范文进行比较和借鉴。总之,第二章的内容由分到多,难度由浅入深,安排合理、得当,学生每前进一步都会有一种成就感,所以能不断深入地学习下去。

三、口语内容有趣、丰富·证题与大学英语四、六级口试题目密切相关。本书共涉及五大类话题范围(Topic Areas):

- 1. 家乡 (Hometown)
- 2. 社会问题 (Social Problems)
- 3. 教育、学校和学校生活 (Education, School and School Life)
- 4. 休闲、爱好、偏爱和经历 (Leisure time, Hobbies, Preference and Experiences)
- 5. 人物、人际关系及相关评论 (People, Human Relationship and Relevant Comment)

所有这些话题均是大家所熟悉的东西,同学们在学习的过程中依靠各种信息支持不会觉得无话可说。

总之,英语口语能力的提髙是一个渐进的过程,必须持之以恒,方能见效,希望本书能对同学们努力学习英语口语起到积极的促进作用。
