### Chapter One Environment

#### A General Survey of Madison's Environment

Madison, the capital of Wisconsin, is a small but very beautiful city. It has been awarded as one of the world's best cities for living for many years mainly because of its unparalleled environment with woods, lakes, ponds, rivers, creeks, steams, parks, lawns every where. It is the heaven of wildlife. Squirrels, hares, ducks, geese, turkeys, badgers can be found easily. All of them live a free and happy life without worrying about the lack of food.

Madison is also called "Lake City" in that it has numerous lakes. The bigger ones include Lake Mendota, Lake Monona, Lake Wingra and Lake Waubeesee. The lakes plus Yahara River, creeks, streams and the woods form a complete water system which can regulate the local climate. It is no doubt that people at Madison can enjoy the climate here. In Winter, it is not too cold though it often snows. In Summer, it is not too hot. The temperature range goes from seventeen degrees below zero to thirty-three degrees centigrade.

Thousands of types of trees can be found at Madison. Among them many trees have been growing for hundreds of years. Generally speaking, if you are walking outside, you can hardly feel thirsty and hungry because of the fruit trees within your reach. The common fruits include cherries, apples, peaches, pears, mulberries etc. In addition, each park equals a botanical garden where you can rest in shade under trees, smell the flowers and listen to the birds chirping.

Madison enjoys a complete law of environmental protection and administrative regulations of environment. The local people have formed the habit of protecting their environment. They are not likely to drop litter. They value every plant. When they need the plants for decorating their home, they will go to the supermarket or arboretum for buying plants in pots instead of digging plants in the woods. If some trees growing are possible to destroy your house, you need apply before cutting. And you can not cut the trees by yourself. Besides, you will pay 2,000 dollars to have a tree cut.


At Madison, you can hardly find the cleaners. The tidy and clean Madison gives the credit to the local people including volunteers and all kinds of environmental associations and organizations. At weekend, the parents will pick up trash together with their kids. The volunteer groups and environmental associations or organizations hold activities regularly. The local government also appropriates funds for related environmental programs like Wellhead Protection Program, Waste Watchers Program, Rain Gardens Program etc.

Environment sustainability receives enough attention. Besides the long-term, medium-term and short-term sustainability plans of Madison, every single house has two garbage cans. The green one is used for the refuse, while the brown one is used for the recycled. At the stipulated time, the garbage truck will empty your garbage cans and carry the garbage away. Further more, there is a can for recycling the batteries at each park.


