## 編輯凡例

- (一) 本字典參照英、美語言學專家所編常用字,並 搜集 各地學校試題範圍,以及日常生活 必須用語編纂而成。
- (二) 本字典單字分節,採用圓點(·),俾與連字符號(Hyphen)區別。分節目的,在(1)使讀者便以研究發音:(2)使讀者於熟習音節後,將來在書寫或打字時,遇有一字須分兩行書寫,則可按音節分開,不致造成錯誤。例如:fa·ther·land, fa·ther-in-law
- (三) 註音採國際音標。國際音標重音符號在應重讀 母音之前,但某字如僅標重音符號而不列音標 時,則仍做韋氏音標,將重音符號放在應重讀 母音之後。

例如:pro·tec'tion 重讀在tec音節,和國際音標的 《prə'tekʃən》將重讀符號(,)放在 tec 音節之前,正好相反。

(四) 凡名詞多數,動詞主要部份,和形容詞或副詞 比較級的規則變化,一概從略,其不規則或在 拼法上易生誤會者,均分別標明。 例如: city n., pl. cities
fish n., pl. fishes 或 fish
speak v., spoke, spo ken, speak ing
shut v., shut, shut ting
well adj. & adv. better. best

- (五) 釋義先用英文,再用中文,並按照使用頻率, 而定①②③④……次序。讀者最好能全部瀏 覽,但若時間不充分,可先記熱①②兩義(即 最常用者),其餘待有充裕時間逐漸増加。
- (六) 單字前有\*標識者,爲最常用字,學習英文的 人均必須熟習,作爲進修的基石。其餘逐漸增 加,則在單字的應用上,已不處置乏了。
- (七) 學習英文的人,往往苦於不能記熟單字。本字 典特針對此點編寫「英文單字簡捷記憶法」 專題介紹記憶單字的快捷方法,附在書後,作 爲一個單獨的部份。讀者如能按照所介紹之方 法細心研習,定必獲事半功倍之效。
- (八) 不規則動詞(Irregular Verbs)一般較難記憶, 好在字數不多,在課本內及一般讀物中出現不 少,看多了,自然會記得。爲了便於檢查,特 列表附在書末,以爲不時之需。
