

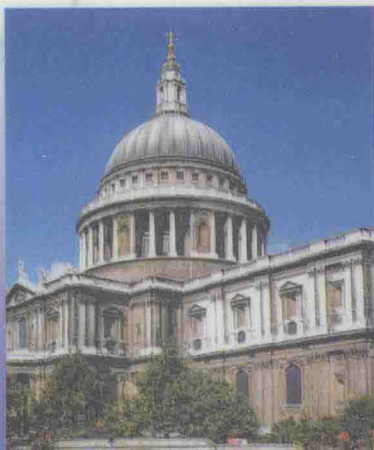

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前 言

《大学英语教学大纲》指出：“大学英语教学的目的，是培养学生具有较强的阅读能力、一定的听力能力、初步的写和说的能力，使学生能以英语为工具，获取专业所需要的信息，并为进一步提高英语水平打下较好的基础。”

由教育部主持的大学英语四、六级考试以及由各省(市)教委主持的大学英语三级考试，在全国范围内为我们检验大学英语教学质量提供了客观统一的标准，对提高我国大学英语教学水平有很大的促进作用。

我们从实际的教学深刻认识到，词汇学习乃是英语学习的重要内容，词汇是英语学习的难点，是学生能否达到大纲要求和通过统考的关键。为了帮助学生掌握词汇，扩大词汇量，我们特编写了这本《大学英语复习教程》(词汇分册)一书。全书共60套题，其中三、四、六级词汇测试题分别为15、35、10套，每套题有30个小题，全书共1800题，共用词汇、词组和短语5000多个，覆盖了《大学英语教学大纲》所列词汇的90%左右。每套题都严格按照三、四、六级考试大纲词汇及实际考试难度设计，并附有一些准确、精炼、易懂、便于记忆的注释，具有很强的针对性和实用性，为所有参加统考的考生考前强化训练的好教材。
