

### 内容提要

## 前 言

EGT考试系由上海市经济委员会委托国家教委 大学考试办公室举办,每年举行两次,其主要目的是测定上海市工程技术和经济管理专业人员的英语能力。为了配合考试,上海市工业系统组织了各种层次的 EGT 培训班。在培训 过程中,广大考生及培训的教学辅导人员都希望能有一本实用的切合实际的辅导读物,以帮助他们在较短时间内 熟悉掌握EGT题型,提高英语能力。本书就是为了满足他们的要求而编写的。

全书收集了作者近几年来的教学材料,反映了在职人员学习英语的难点及容易犯的错误。全书有两个特点:第一,实用性强。本书按EGT考试大纲编写,书中题型与EGT考题完全一致。各项练习题后附有参考答案。本书可作为EGT培训的辅导教材,也可作为考生自读自测的练习材料。第二,内容全面。书中全部词汇和语法项目严格按EGT考试大纲筛选过,覆盖了大纲的基本内容与要求。内容编排与实际 EGT考题编排一致。考生阅读本书,既可提高英语知识水平,增强阅读技能,又能熟悉等级考试的方法和要求,掌握应试技巧。

本书主要为参加 EGT-C 考试的考生编写, 但对其他 层次的考生及同等英语水平的读者都有所裨益。

本书在編写过程中, 曾得到市工业系統部分外语教师及 有关同志的大力协助。在此表示衷心的感谢。

由于水平有限,错误及不当之处在所难免,谨请读者不吝指正。

## 词汇和语法结构(多项选择题)

Vocabulary and Structure(multiple choice)

### 一、方法指导

EGT-C试卷第一部分(PART I)第一项(Section A)试题 是多项选择题。这类试题的目的是测试考生实际运用词汇, 短语和语法结构的能力;由于词汇和语法是组成语言的基础,又是阅读理解的必要前提。一般水平考试都将这部分内 容放在试题的首位。

多项选择题(multiple choice) 是综合性的,它涉及词汇、短语、词法、句法等各个方面。为便于有针对性的答题,将多项选择题分为两大类。

1. 词语 (vocabulary) 类型题,该题型主要考虑词语 的 几种情况。

选择同义词或近义词 (synonym or approx.), 关键是要掌握词义与用法。

正确使用词与其他词的搭配,尤其是词尾小词,介词 (preposition),副词(adverb)等,另外,这里还包括固定搭配词组(a set phrase)的选用。

正确使用词性(parts of speech),如辨别及使用形容词、副词、名词、动词等。

正确区分词形相同或近 似 的 易 混 词 (easily confused words),包括相同词的不同用法,词头、词尾相同等各类易混词。

2. 语法 (Structure) 类型题。这类题型主要考虑语法情况:

时态(tense),这种情况的关键是要看清句中的时间状语,若是主从复合句,还应注意主句与从句中谓语动词的呼应。

一致关系 (agreement), 主要考虑主语人称, 数与 谓 语的对应关系, 尤其要注意主语可数与不可数等现象。

主从复合句 (principal and subordinate clause),要正确分析引导从句的关联词,连接词和关系代词,从而分清从句所属,正确判断句型。

非谓语动词(verbals),这里要掌握不同类型的非谓语在句中各自的作用,并且熟悉时态、语态的变化。

除上所述外,还有语态问题,强调句型等。值得一提的是,EGT-C 试题语法项目按 EGT 考试大纲为准,大纲规定虚拟语气(subjunctive mood),倒装(inversion)结构(不包括疑问句),省略(omission)不是C级的考试范围,这一点提请注意,不要在这方面花太大的气力。

做多项选择题时,须注意:

- (1) 仔细阅读句子,辨清题型类别。可按 每 题 A、B、C、D 四个选择项亲分清该题属于词语类型还是语法结 构 类型。
- (2) 若是词语类型,思考的重点应放在四个选择项的词义和用法上,然后逐一排除最不可能的答案,直至得到最合

#### 话的答案。

- (3) 若是语法类型。要对句子做充分的语法分析。考虑 的重点是回顾有关的语法规则及相应的词类变化形式。
- (4) 不管是词语类型还是语法类型。从综合分析入手。 都会获得更具科学性的答案。有了最合话答案后。还要将其 放回句中,校核一下,看看句子是否通顺,语法、逻辑是否 合理。
- (5) 平时学习。阅读时要加强理解和记忆、经常做对比 分析, 熟悉大纲的语法使用规则, 尤其是词汇方面, 有相当 部分要靠考生较长时期的积累才能真正熟练掌握。
