## 前言

与时代脉搏一起跳动的CNN(美国有线新闻网)是世界新闻的领导者,同时也为英语教学工作者和英语学习者的教与学提供了实况**的小式泰加、不可多**得的视听材料。其内容丰富而多彩,视角独特且全面,涉及政治、经济、**小流各方面话题**以及其他社会热点话题,同时不乏自然、健康等社会生活各方面的内容。可以**表现**夸张地说了CNN所报道的内容本身就是一个百科全书,无论是英语专业的还是其他专业的**补充**高兴趣的太学生和研究生,都可以从中获取广泛的实用信息,更重要的是,可以从这里学到地道的、原产原味的英语表达,提高我们的英语听说水平,增强我们的英语实力。

课时设置方面,上册1—4单元每课可供一课时使用。第5、6单元为电视剧集,每课供两课时使用,第7、8单元为电影,每课供三课时使用。下册1—6单元每课可供一课时使用。第7单元为电视剧集,每课供两课时使用,第8、9、10单元为电影,每课供三课时使用。每单元课数不等,教师可自由选择课时数。

在内容选择上,教师也可以将上、下册各单元中的各课材料贯通、交叉使用,采取"新闻+新闻""新闻+电视剧""新闻+电影"等不同方式,以最大限度地激发学生的学习兴趣和热情并保证学习材料的新鲜感。

本书分为学生用书上、下两册和教师用书上、下两册。其中教师用书对中国学生不易理解、涉及西方文化(尤其是美国文化)的难点重点内容进行了详细的、图文并茂的解释和说明,为教师备课提供了有利的条件。

此外,编者还将CNN英语新闻的文字听抄出来,并保证其准确性和权威性,供广大教师参考使用。

本教材特点如下:

- 1. 选材新颖, 角度独特;
- 2. 内容丰富, 信息量大;
- 3. 语言标准、地道、生动、幽默;
- 4. 练习设计丰富,适宜课堂教学。




