

怎样才能将英语单词记得又快又牢? 这是词汇学习中公认的难 题。对于即将参加六级考试的考生来说,满目的陌生词汇让人不知所 措。英语单词学习能否速成? 众多考生苦苦追问。为此我们经过多年 的研究和试验,推出了这本《大学英语六级词汇巧战一本通》。

本书严格按照《大学英语教学大纲词汇表》中的词汇编写, 囊 括了大纲中的所有词汇,同时也涵盖了历年真题中所出现的常考超 纲词汇。

本书把大纲词汇按难易程度进行了分级,考生可根据自身的英语 水平选择合适有效的复习策略。本书打破了以往很多词汇书主次不清、 难易不分、平均分配时间和精力的编排方式,而是给考生以更明确的 指导,既节省了时间,又提高了效率,从而帮助考生在最短的时间内 全面掌握和运用六级词汇。

本书想考生之所想,在以下方面精心构思:

为加强复习的针对性, 本书首先给出了基础词汇和高频词汇测试 成绩与复习建议对照表,对不同程度的考生给予不同的复习建议。

本书正文包括六级基础词汇、六级高频词汇、六级低频词汇和六 级超纲词汇四个部分。在基础词汇和高频词汇前各提供了一定数量的 测试题, 考生在学习词汇之前最好先自我测试, 根据测试成绩, 再参 照本书提供的建议, 制定出自己的复习计划。

本书高频词汇部分采用的是以句带词、以词带词的独到编排方法。 本书一反词汇手册和工具书以词带句的惯常安排,而是先呈现给读者 一个在历年真题中出现的句子,而后才是单词的常规信息。为了有效 地帮助考生横向快速扩展词汇,本书在这一部分设置了"想一想"栏 目,率先推出了让考生耳目一新的"联想词"。这样做可以让考生开阔 视野,举一反三,成串记忆。因为这一部分的单词是考生应重点掌握 的单词, 考生不但要掌握单词的几层意思及其扩展词, 还要熟悉其用 法。另外, 英语中有许多特殊用法、习惯搭配, 这是在语言长期的形 成和发展过程中保留下来的,无法套用一般的语法规则来解释。针对 这种情况,本书在相关词条下设有"名师导学"栏目,虽寥寥数语, 却能一针见血地解开许多考生百思不解的疑惑。

本书的另一个重要特点就是高度重视历年真题。本书所有的例句 摘自过去十几年来的全真六级试卷, 例句出自全真试题之多、涉及全 真试题面之广, 前所未有, 这也是六级考试之前极好的热身训练。为

了帮助考生更好地比较同义项在英汉双语语境中的异同,以及更好地学习记忆词汇,我们对例句也附上了汉语译文,让考生在记忆词汇的同时,进行考试真题的实战演练,以使考生在考场上面对试题时也能从容不迫、驾轻就熟。

本书附录的编排也打破了常规的结构安排,加入了六级常用词组和六级写作词汇两类应试性内容。使考生既能掌握单词、词组,又能提高写作能力。

本书为考生提供了最佳的六级英语词汇解决方案。仔细研读本书,突破词汇难关指日可待。
