最新托福字彙突破

序

托福單字最近幾次以來的趨勢大概可以從三方面來說，

- 1.不再有艱深冷僻的難字例如(GRE 單字)，而出些常見而常用的單字，但是所出的都是這些單字的非基本用法，也就是說一個單字同學不少只記一個意義，而要多了解其他常用的解釋。
- 2.副詞的比例大幅提高，這與以往偏重於形容詞與名詞不同，同學們應多加注重副詞的解釋。
- 3.閱讀測驗中的單字，經過一年多以後，就會出現在單字部份，因此在閱讀測驗中的單字，同學應該加以分類整理，尤其是最近三、四次的考題。

本書收錄的單字與片語均是常用者，較難的單字與片語均不予以列入，以期在最短的時間內，使同學能達到溫習的最大效果。唯作者資質魯鈍，如有疏漏之處，望諸先進賜教為荷。
