

4. Conference on Bird Flu Draws Pledges of \$ 1.9 Billion

That vast distance is one we have now crossed. We have communication, cooperation, trade, exchanges. For example, in 1972, there were no Americans as tourists in the P.R.C; last year there were over 100,0000. In 1972, there were no students from the P.R.C studying in the United States; last year there were over 12,000. In 1972, there was no trade between the two countries; last year trade went over six billion dollars That's an 2) of what has happened in just 13 short years. In recent years,

China has been working hard and creatively at 3) _____ a system that works for China at this period of its history and this stage of its development. The progress for example that China has made in just the 13 years since I was first here has greatly exceeded the 4)____, and they were fairly high, that I had at that time.

As I look ahead to the 21st century –to your century – I see one world. But the one world I see is not a world without differences between nations or peoples.
