Central Intelligence Agency (CIA): Agency of the Executive Office of the President of the United States, created in 1947, together with the National Security Council. The CIA is America's first permanent peacetime intelligence agency responsible for keeping the government informed of foreign actions affecting the nation's interests. It was estab-

lished by the National Security Act of 1947 and is charged with coordinating all U.S. intelligence activities, as well as such functions and duties related to intelligence as directed by the National Security Council. A director and a deputy director of the agency are appointed by the President with the consent of the Senate.

阿尔巴尼亚 Albania, meaning Eagle's Country, republic in south-eastern Europe, located in the western part of the Balkan Peninsula. It is one of the smallest countries of Europe, having a maximum length from north to south of about 345 km and a maximum width of 145 km. The total area is 28,748 sq. km. Tirana is the capital and largest city. Albania's part in the Kosovo conflict was delicate in that it supported the Kosovo Liberation Army but did not participate in NATO's bombing campaign against Yugoslavia.
