The Listening Comprehension section tests your ability to understand spoken English. It measures your ability to discriminate among sounds and words as well as to understand the grammar of spoken English.

Part A Statements

Part B Conversations

Part C Mini-talks

Part A

In this section of the test, you must match a written statement with an oral statement. You must choose a sentence with a similar meaning from the four written sentences in the test book. This section will test your ability to distinguish between words that sounds alike; your ability to distinguish among numbers; Your ability to recognize grammatical markers; Your ability to recognize discourse markers; And your ability to recognize synonyms.

Part B

In this section, Conversations, you must answer a question about a conversation between two people. The question, which is asked by a third person, tests your ability in the same areas as Part A. Again, there may be words in the answer choices that are similar to the words in the conversation. You must pay attention to the meaning of the conversation.

Part C

In Part C, Mini-talks, you will answer several ques-

tions about a snort passage. The subjects discussed may be in a variety of areas. The topics used in this section may be announcements; advertisements; reports; academic lectures; informative talks and so on.
