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

# 序

## 徐清学

为了弘扬新加坡、马来西亚琼籍华侨、归侨、侨眷,对侨居国,对祖国的建设作出的巨大贡献,在各界人士的大力支持下,《新马赤子》一书终于出版了。

新加坡、马来西亚琼籍华侨历史悠久,琼州人前往新、马两国已有数百年的历史了。马六甲、太平等埠的琼州会馆创立于1869年;槟城琼州会馆在1870年前就存在了,可见当时移殖马六甲、太平、槟城等埠的海南人已不少了。十五世纪中叶,海南移殖马来亚(包新加坡)逐渐增多,1970年统计,有159210人,1947年也有15764人,至1980年, 单马来西亚就有二十多万海南人。

新、马两国海南华侨的由来原因是多方面的,主要是历代统治阶级的经济剥削及政治迫害而离乡别井远涉重洋到异国他乡另谋生活,他们的智慧与勤劳,对居住国和祖国的经济发展与繁荣立下了不朽的功劳。

有华侨才有归侨、侨眷。新、马归侨侨眷人数众多。在 殖民统治下,部份华侨也因经济、政治原因,在各个时期返 回祖国,而较多的则是解放前后,他们回国后,有的上学深 造,有的参加祖国的革命与建设,因而不少海南新、马归侨、 侨眷成为党政机关、工厂企业、文教卫生战线的骨干与负责 人。

《新马赤子》所选入的新、马两国的琼籍华侨、归侨、 侨眷人物,属于知名的侨领、学者、企业家,政界要人等仍 是少数,多数是普通的机关干部、技术人员、医务工作及数 育工作者,他们虽不是名人,但他们有一颗诚实的心,任劳 任怨的奉献精神,默默无闻地在各自的岗位上,对祖国的事 业作出应有的贡献,他们的事迹用文字记戴下来,教育后一 代,我认为是很有意义的。

我是本书的编委主任之一,据我所知,《新马赤子》一书,在编写过程中,也遇到一些困难,主要是资料缺乏,不全不足,因此已写进本书的人物,也因囿于占有的材料,内容不够充实,有零碎之感,因此,有些人物内容多些,有些少些,这都是因手头资料限制所致,并非厚此薄彼。本书收集的新、马琼籍"三侨"人物只是很少的一部分,今后争取出版续集。

#### Foreword

With the great support given by the personalities Of various circles, this book "The Pure In Heart Of Singapore And Malaysia Overseas Chinese, Returned Overseas Chinese And Their Relatives" is published in order to propagate the great contribution made by them at home and abroad.

Hainan Overseas Chinese in Singapore and Malaysia have a long history. The people of Hainan have settled in Singapore and Malaysia for several hundred years. Hainan (Qiongzhou) Association in Melaka, Taiping, etc. were established in 1869. Before 1870, Hainan (Qiongzhou) Association in Penang had already been established. At that time the peole of Hainan had migrated in largenumder in Melaka, Taiping and Penang, etc. During the midfifteen century, the people of Hainan

migrated to Malaysia and Singapore increased rapidly. Stactistics showed in 1970, there were 159.21 thousand; in 1947, there were 15.764 thousand; in 1980, alone in Malaysia there were 200 thousand.

The cause of immigration of the people of Hainan into Singapore and Malaysia was in many ways. The main reason was that they were exploited economically and persecuted politically by the ruling classes of past ages and were forced to leave their nat i ve places. In foreign countries, through their wisdom and hard work, they have made great contribution to the development of economy and the prosperity to the country they are living and their motherland.

Where there are overseas Chinese, there are returned overseas Chinese and their relatives. Returned oversea Chinese and their relatives have a very large population. Under the colonial rule, some of the overseas Chinese came back to the motherland at different

periods due to their economic or political problems. Most of them were back after liberaton. Some went for further study, others joined in the revolution or socialist constructions. However, many of them have become key members, or persons in charge of party and government offices, factories, enterprises, cultural and educational circles and public health centers.

Singapore and Malaysia overseas Chinese, returned overseas Chinese and their relatives with Hainan's root included in this book are only a few famous overseas leaders, scholars, entrepreneurs or key members in political circles. However, a great number of them included in this book are ordinary cadres of government functionary, technicians, medical workers and teachers. Though they are not eminent persons, they work hard at their posts with their honest hearts. I think it is of great significance to write down their deeds in order to educate our coming generation.
