

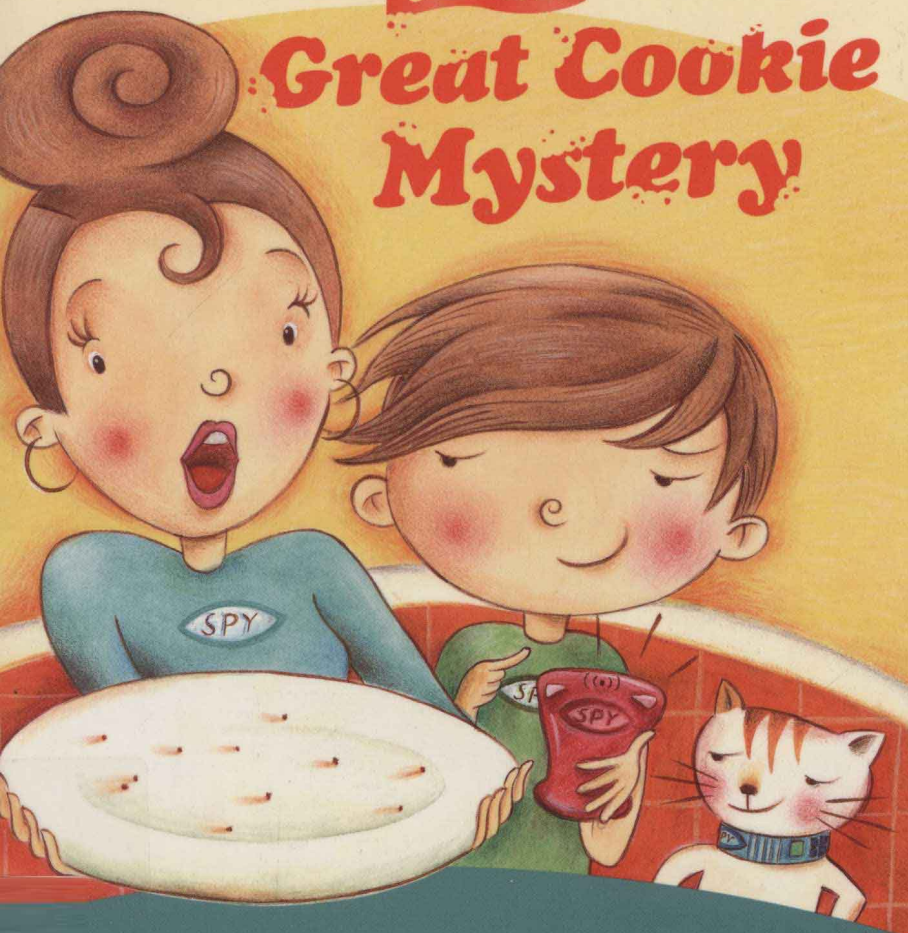

It was empty.

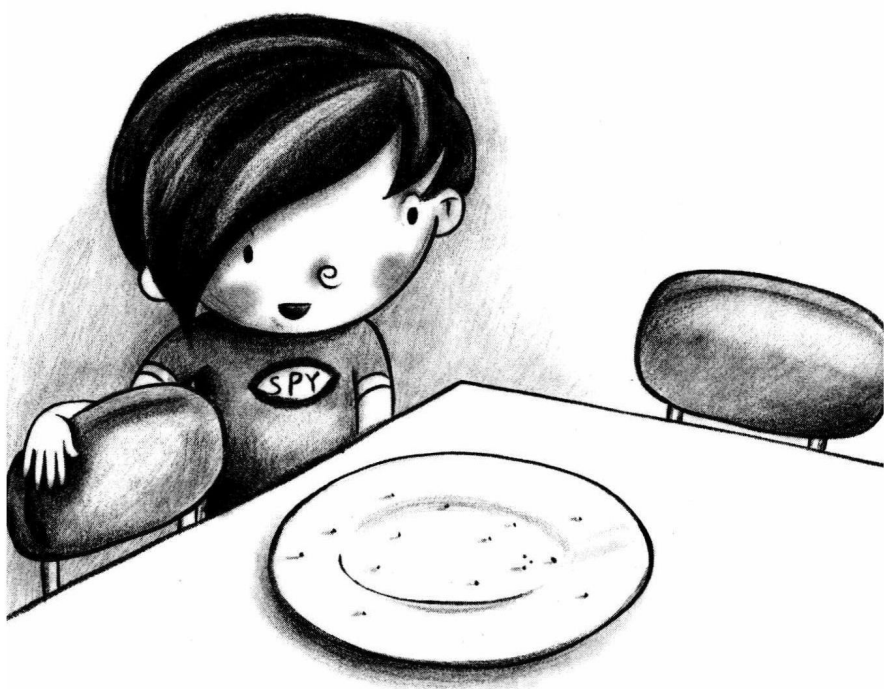
'Do we have mice?' he
