






### Who Faels, SCOTES A book about being afraid







In Jack's bedroom, they heard a noise. Robin thought it was a **lion**. Ravi thought it was a **tiger**. They were so scared they hid!




### But Jack wasn't Scared at all.








Then they all heard a *really* scary noise. It was coming from Jack's cupboard. They thought it was a **monster**.
