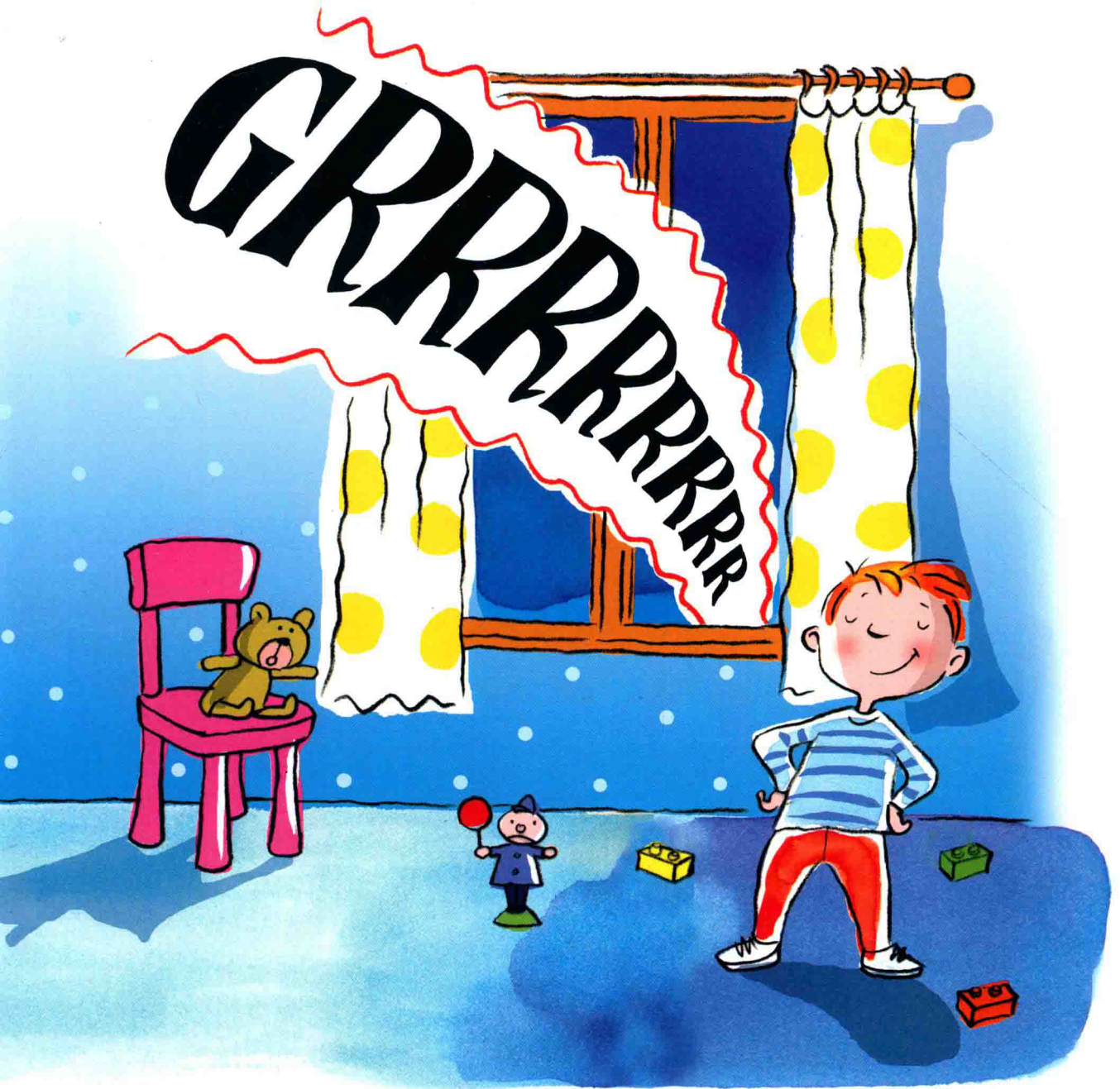




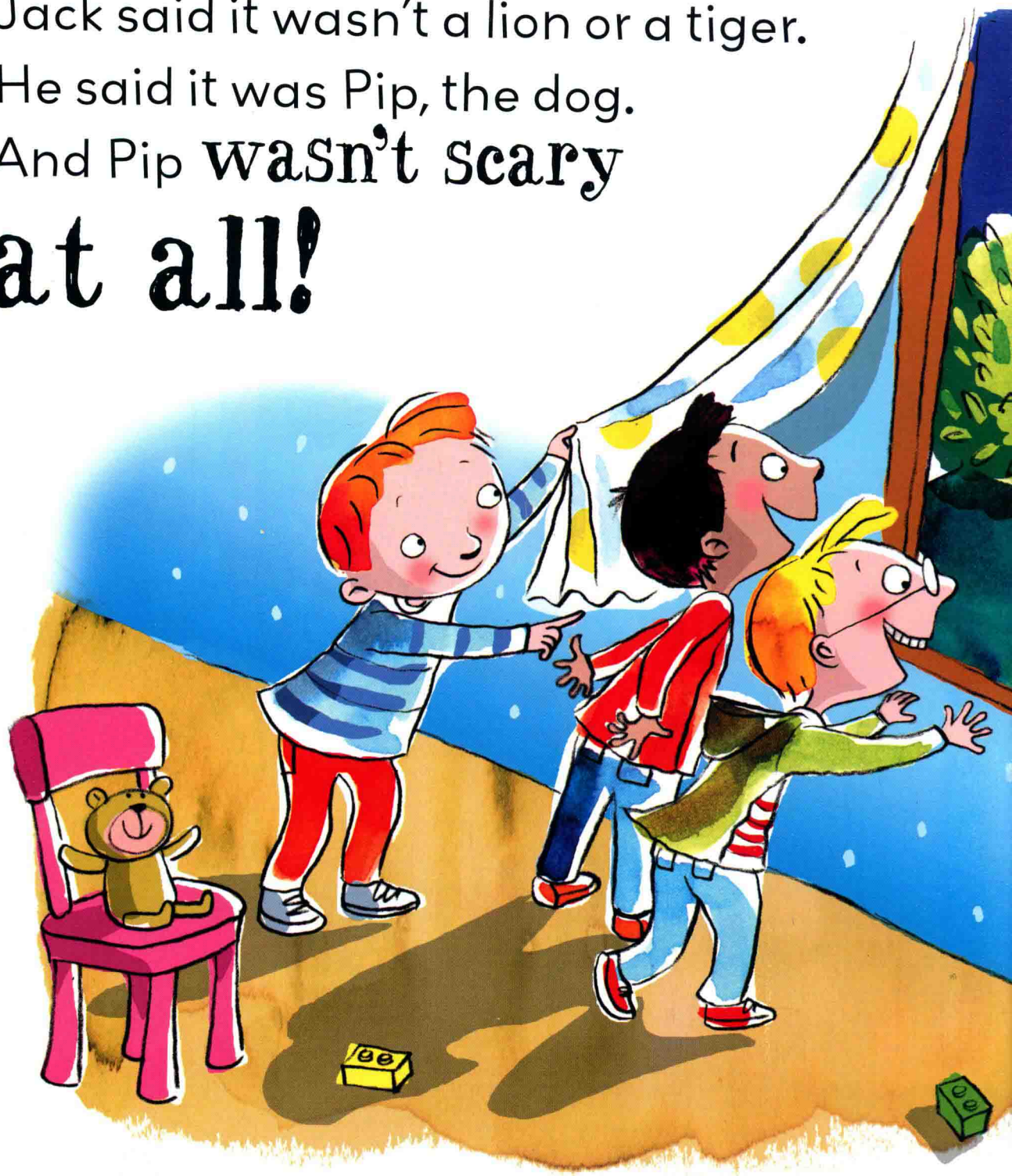
In Jack's bedroom, they heard a noise.

They were so scared they hid!

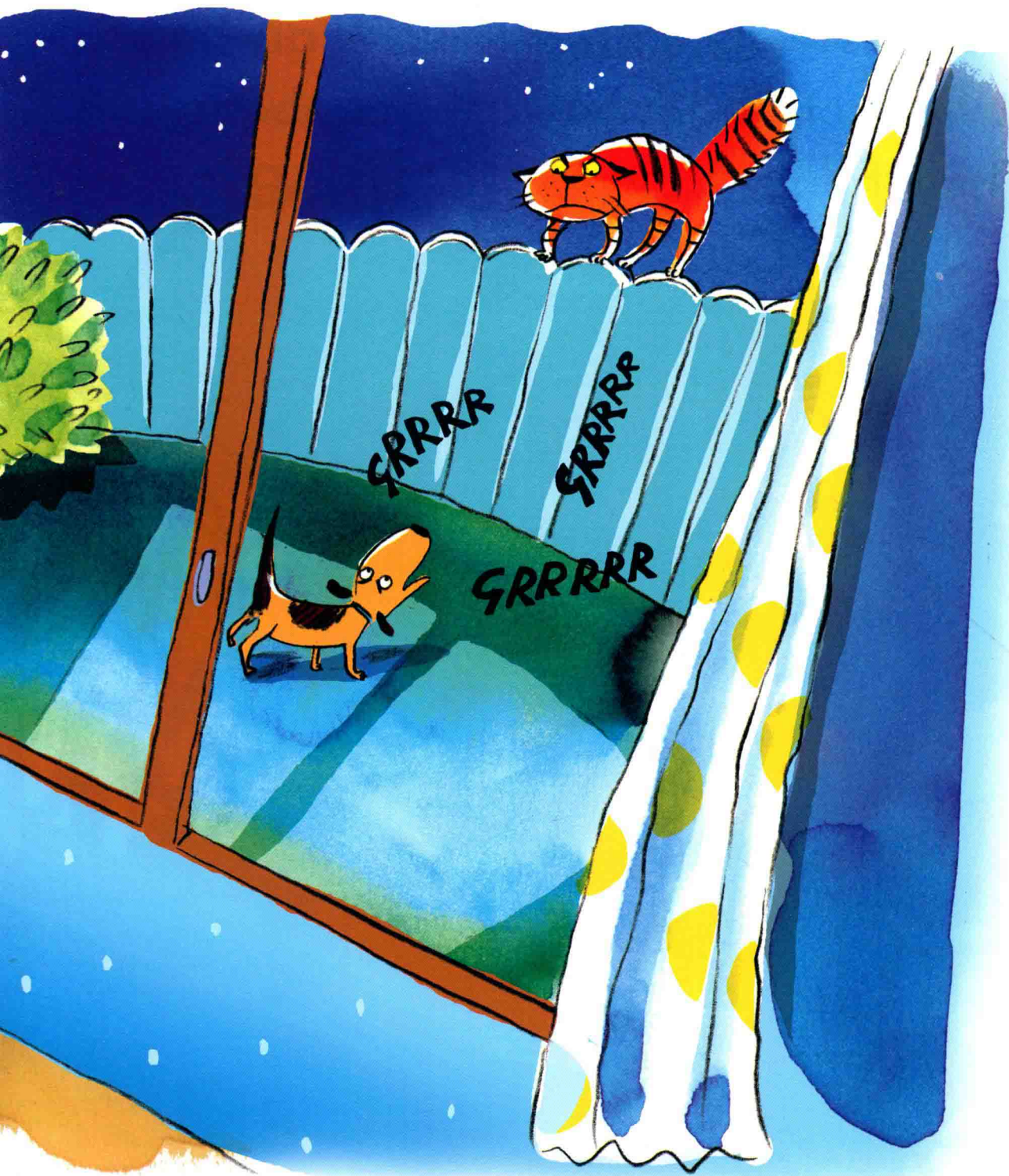


But Jack wasn't Scared at all.

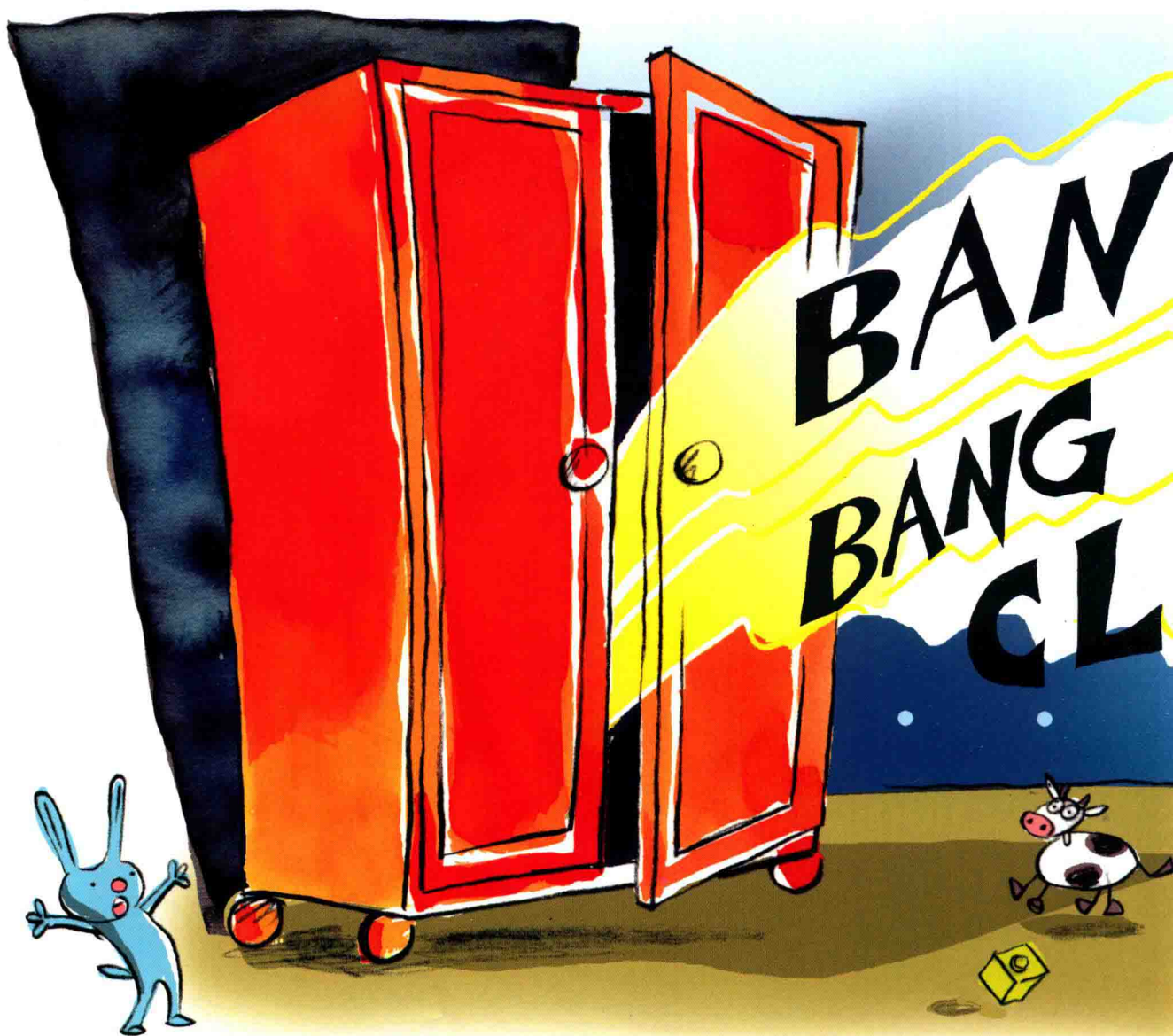


Jack said it wasn't a lion or a tiger.
