## Monthly Operational Summary

### **June 1984**

The Monthly Operational Summary provides information about projects contemplated for financing by the World Bank, information that appears as much as 24 months before the loan or credit is ready for presentation to the World Banks Executive Directors for approval. The information is updated each month as the stage of processing advances, from preparation by the borrowing country and appraisal by the Bank through loan negotiations to final approval. Projects are removed from the Summary when the loan or credit has been signed, or when a decision is made not to proceed; this is announced in the Summary. Goods and works to be procured by international competitive bidding, will be advertised as General Procurement Notices in <u>Development Forum Business Edition</u>.

This document will provide you with the earliest leads to business opportunities arising from World Bank financing. However, inasmuch as these projects are in various stages of preparation, their form might substantially change, or they might be dropped altogether. As this information is updated monthly and is complete, inquiries should not be necessary, but in any case should be directed to the implementing agencies, or the borrower's embassies not to the World Bank.

Entries are classified by region and by World Bank member country. Each entry is preceded by an abbreviation indicating the category of project (see full list on the next page). (N) before the project description indicates it is a new listing in the Summary; (R) indicates a <u>revision</u> or change, however minor, from the previous month's Summary.

The entry first indicates the borrower or implementing agency for the proposed project. If the government itself is the borrower, the name of its implementing agency is noted too; this is the agency to be contacted in regard to the project. If the government is not the borrower, the borrower's name is given instead in capital letters and in parentheses. Again this is the agency to be contacted. Next, the amount anticipated from the loan or credit is noted, as well as the probable lender (Bank or IDA-see Glossary). The figure thus listed refers to millions of US dollars and is approximate or tentative.

The estimated total cost of the project and its foreign exchange component are provided where available. Finally there is information, if any, about action with respect to the procurement of goods and services expected to be financed by the Bank or IDA, and the prospects for co-financing.

Where no borrowing agency, loan amount or stage of procurement is given, it is yet to be determined. Thus, an entry may contain a dollar figure and a description, without an agency assigned to implement it, for example. In such cases, the government is the responsible party to contact.

Notices for goods and services to be procured through international competitive bidding appear in <u>Development Forum Business Edition</u>, published twice a month by the Division for Economic and Social Information, United Nations.
