INCIDENTAL

: Excerpt of CIC Interrogation of Kuzuu. "-Reasoned Kuzuu, when the U.S. broke the Trade Treaty in 1941, began to rearm and to conscript personnel for the Army, Japan had to strike first to protect herself; the result was Pearl Harbor."

Kuzuu, President of the Black Dragon (Kikuryukai) and Toyama's right hand man was appointed Director of the IRAA in 1940, which act was a public acknowledgement of Black Dragon Principles and Platform, but the society, as a society, still remained in the background; it was not until 1943 that Kuzuu, speaking in the name of the society for the first time in its history, came out with an open threat against Roosevelt and Churchill; the announcement of a banquet on Oct. 29, 1943 to homor India and Rosh Bihari. Rose-from OSS, R&A, F.E., Cct 30 1943.

Nationalist Training School in Tokyo, organized by Toyoma and maintained by Kokuryukai (Black Dragon Soc.) of which Kuzuu is head .- From OSS, Wash. 21 Feb. 44.

Excerpt from an interrogation of one Tokuda, a Jap Communist leader, on his opinions of the Shiddehara Cabinet. "The present head of the Black Dragon Society, Kuzuu, is simply a "front" man and the power in it is Kojima. Kojima is actively assisting Izawa in the latters Cabinet Making efforts."

#### Additional Data:

"President and Executive Director of the BLACK DRAGON SOCIETY. Recently addressed a communication to ROOSEVELT and CHURCHILL which pointed out Japan's war aims, one of these being the freedom on nations and the peace of the world." (C.I.S.O.S.S. card file - FCC Daily Report, June 4, 1943).

"Representative of the TAISEI YCKUSANKAI Among various Japanese who called on the President of the new Republic of the Philippines on Oct. 15th." (CISOSS Card File - FCC Daily Report, Oct 15, 1943).

"President of the BLACK DYAGON (NOKURYUKAI) and TOYAMA'S right hand man. Was appointed director of the IMPERIAL RULE ASSISTANCE ASSOCIATION in 1940, which act was a public acknowledgment of Black Dragon principles and platform, but the society, as a society, still remained in the tackground; it was not until June 1943 that MUZUU, speaking in the name of the society for the first time in its higtory, came out with an open threat against ROOSEVELT and CHURE CHILL; the announcement off a banquet on Oct 29, 1943 to honor INDIA and Rash Bihari Bose." (CISOSS Card File—OSS, R & A, F-E, No. 30, Oct 30, 1943).

"Director of the I.R.A.A. Among those to be present at a dinner to be given by the Black Dragon Society on Oct. 29th; Mitsuru TOYAMA is Chief of this society." (CTSOSS card file - FCC Dailt Report, Oct 23, 1943).

"Head of the secret arganization KOKURYUKAI, also a director of the IRAA: this is probably the foremost of all the secret societies and maintains several successful schools, one of which is the Nationalist Training School Tokyo which was organized by TOYAMA." (CISOSS card file -- OSS, Washington, 21 Feb 1944.

"Member of Black Dragon Society. Said the enemy had bombed the ISE SHRINE with "knowing intention." (CISOSS card file -- FCC Daily Report 15 Jan 45).

"Chairman of the DAI NIPPON Patriotic Association."(CISOSS card file - DONEI in Romaji, FCC Daily Report, 18 Jan 45). Note: spelling of name in report was "Kuzuwu; Japanese characters for l'UZUU and KUZUWA is said to be the same, however.

"Leader of SINJI TAISEI KYOKA RENMEI LEAGUE for the strengthening of Wartime Policy; advisor to the GREAT JAPAN PRODUCTION PARTY (DAI NIPPON SUSANTO); director of DAI-NIHON-SHISAN (GREAT JAPAN JABOR PARTY). Party was established 28 June 1931 and its greatest efforts have been spent on the clarification of the national policy and in farmers' relief. Its Nazi-type theories were designed to replace the waning appeal of the Black Dragon Society in the face of new economic and political ideas." (CIS Operations Card File on Reactionary Groups).

"Vice-chairman of MITSURU TOYAMA Funeral Committee (announced on 6 Oct 44 President of the Black Dragon Society (KOKURYU KAI). " (CIS Operations Card File on Reactionary Groups.)

"Another sadistic police inspector was FUJII" (CIC Report File on ABE, Ginki) (Note: No first name given - may not be YOHIHISA) (CIS Operations Card File on Reactionary Groups).

Comments: This organization's greatest efforts have been spent on the clarification of the national policy and in farmers' relief. In the latter, it has been brought about good effects in the northeast and Sanin (the Japan Sea side of western Japan) districts. In Formosa, the local branch of this organization was active in the Juneau(?) incident and was highly praised for its efforts.

Program: To obey the Imperial Constitution and to thoroughly carry out the good government in which Emperor and people are one; to reform and abolish all systems and laws which are not appropriate in the progress of the national policy and the nation, and to simplify the governmental system; to establish the fundamentals of a self-sufficient national economy.

Organ: Dai Nihon Seisen-To-Ho (Journal of the Great Japan Labour Party)
Monthly.

On 28 November the undersigned received the complete CIS file on the Black Dragon Society (Kokuryu Kai). Having made a careful study of the file, it is concluded that there is contained therein nothing that would have any direct bearing on the case now being investigated by this office. The file contains an interview with Yoshihisa KUZUU, president of the Black Dragon Society, who is now in custody as a War Criminal plus a translation of the Society's 1928 prospectus and a chronological account of some of the activities of the ociety from 1901 to 1928: Other than to show the Rightist tendiencies of the organization and to indicate the influence it wielded behind the government these documents contain nothing of any value to this case. There is also contained a list of the names of persons who accepted or refused invitations to a dinner given by the Society in March, 1928, and a list of the names and addresses of persons having accepted free food and lodging at the Society's quarters. There is also several mi itary communications mentioning the names of persons having some possible connection with the Black Dragon Society. None of names mentioned appear to be of any value to the case at hand.

On 9 January 1946 the records of the Personnel Section, Cabinet Secretariat were examined at the Diet Building, Tokyo.

Following is a transcript of the translation:

## YCSHIHISA KUZUU (SHUKICHI)

BORN:

16 September 1874

RESIDENCE:

No. 5, Aoba-Cho, Shibuya-Ku, Tokyo City

1887

Graduated from the Kofunagi Primary School at Shiishiba-Mura, Kajjyo-gun, Chiba-Ken and since then studied without a teacher

1893 Nov

Went to Korea and inspected conditions

1896 Jan

Again went to Korea and engaged in the research of her situation and fishery and afterwards compiled and published the "Guide to the Korean Seas Fishery"

1901 Feb

Founded with Ryohei USHIDA and others the KOKURYU-KAI (Black Dragon Society) and engaged in its management under the superintendence of Rychei UCFIDA

1903 Nov

Proceeded to Korea and while inspecting conditions, created at Fusan the "Chosen-Nippo-Sha" (Korean Daily Newspaper Office)

1906 Nov

Returned to Tokyo and since then was engaged continually in the management of the KOKURYU-KAI

1923 Oct

On the occasion of the Kanto earthquake, engaged in the relief works of the KOKURYC-KAI. After that, when the Society has established the Liberal Works Club, engaged in its supervision in the same time pursuing the Society's Affairs

1938 Dec	Became the Vice President of the said association
1939 Mar 28	Appointed as a member of the KCKUMIN-SEISHIN-SCICIN-IINKWAI (Committee of the Spiritual Awakening Movement) (Cabinet)
1942 Oct 12	Assumed the post of Director of the TAISET-YOKUSAN-KAI (Imperial Rule Assistance Association)
1944 Dec 2€	Appointed as a pro tem member of the Committee of the "CHOSEN-OYOBI-TAIWAN AZIJUMIN SEIJI-SHOGU CHOSA-KAI" (Political Treatment Investigation Society for the Nationals in Korea and Formosa) (Cabinet)
1945 May 9	Requested to be a delegate to the Conference of the "KOKUMIN-GIYUTAI" (National Volunteer Corps) (Cabinet)
