

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
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前 言

Foreword

本书在策划与编写过程中,主要遵循了以下原则:


★收词适当,紧跟时代。英语中的词汇浩如烟海,本书在编写过程中最大限度地以人性化、科学化设计为前提,按词汇的重要程度及使用频率进行归纳和整理,所选词汇均为紧跟时代发展的最新词汇。

★近义词汇,全面收录。本书中所列词汇,力求做到与其意思相同相近相关的单词及短语全部收纳,最大程度上丰富了学习使用者的同义词近义词词汇量,使其在选词达意时可以信手拈来,灵活运用。

★注明音标,方便记忆。本书中每个词条都注明了音标,便于读者边读边记,在记忆单词的同时,可以根据标准音标学习和纠正单词读音,由此避免了英语学习中只会看不会说的现象出现。

★开本较小,便于携带。本书在编写过程中,充分考虑到当今快节奏的工作与生活给学习时间及阅读场所带来的限制,开本设计较小,方便读者携带与阅读。
