# 前言

《大学英语读写教程》是针对高职高专学生的特点,专门为高职高专院校学生量身打造的新颖、实用的英语教材。该教材严格按照教育部颁布的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》的要求,由众多具有丰富教学经验的一线教师进行编写。

#### 一、编写原则

《大学英语读写教程》贯彻教育部高职高专英语教学改革的精神,遵循"以学生为中心,以实用为主、够用为度"的原则,按照"以项目为支撑的模块化教学改革"的要求,使学生在牢固掌握基础语言知识和基本技能的基础上,通过丰富的语言输入与多样的练习形式,进一步提高学生在不同情境下的语言实际应用能力。

#### 二、教材特色

《大学英语读写教程》所选主题广泛,贴近学生生活,关注时代热点,体现职业特色,注重信息性、实用性和趣味性。课文题材多样,语言地道、规范,课后练习紧扣课文内容,既注重各项能力训练之间的衔接和互补,也注重篇章层次上的一体化技能训练。

#### 三、内容构成

《大学英语读写教程》可供高职高专一年级学生两学期使用,第一学期44个学时,第二学期20学时,共计64学时。

本教材共设10个单元,每单元包括5个模块:

#### 1. Leading In

设置在单元开始,为该单元的话题导入部分,提供与单元主题相关的讨论问题, 引导学生熟悉主题并积极参与本单元的话题讨论。

#### 2. Text A

精选反映当代现实生活、西方文化习俗、现代科技、文化娱乐、语言学习、学生校园文化的英文佳作为精读课文。课后配有相关的阅读理解、词汇、句型、句子翻译等

练习。

#### 3. Text B

精选与单元主题相关的另一篇同类文章为泛读课文。课后配有相关的课文理解 和词汇练习。

#### 4. Grammar Revision

针对语法学习而设置并配有相关练习,旨在全面系统地对中学阶段学过的主要语法知识进行梳理和归纳,帮助学生全面巩固和积极拓展语法知识。

#### 5. Practical Writing

英语应用文写作是让学生在掌握各种应用文体的正确格式的基础上培养学生 阅读、写作和翻译应用文的能力,内容包括注册表、名片、贺卡、信函、便条、标志语及 电子邮件等常见应用文体。

#### 四、编写成员

《大学英语读写教程》由党红担任主编。参加编写的人员有赵典凯、周爱华、马玖英、王慧斌、付文菁、张洁敏。

本书具体编写分工如下:

#### 二、英语的基本句型

英语句子的基本成分有主语、谓语、宾语、状语、补语五种。根据英语句子的基本结构,可以归纳成六种主要句型,掌握这六种基本句型,是掌握各种英语句子结构的基础。

1. 英语句子的基本成分

S=主语(subject) V=谓语动词(verb)

O=宾语(object) Oi=间接宾语(indirect object)

Od=直接宾语(direct object) A=状语(adverbial)

C=补足语(complement) P=表语(predicate)

- 2. 六种主要英语句型(Sentence Pattern)
- (1) SV "主语+谓语(不及物动词)"

这种句型中的谓语动词是不及物动词,不能带宾语,但可带有状语。例如:
