

PREFACE

The first volume of the English language *Flora of China* appeared in 1994. In order to increase the usefulness of these text volumes, and to make available the beautiful drawings used for the previously published Chinese language *Flora Reipublicae Popularis Sinicae* (FRPS), the *Flora of China Illustrations* series was started in 1998. The illustrations series follows the taxonomy of the text series, but some modifications in presentation have been made so that FRPS figures can fit into the present scheme. Additional illustrations are also included for taxa not or insufficiently illustrated in FRPS.

Volume 20–21 of the *Flora of China Illustrations* is vols. 20 and 21 combined into a single volume; hence it is the 21st of the now 22 volumes of the *Flora of China Illustrations*. It accompanies the *Flora of China* (FOC) Volume 20–21, which was published in 2011 and treated 15 tribes, 252 genera, and 2,340 species in Asteraceae. This volume of illustrations includes 722 plates representing a total of 1,214 species in 204 genera.

The illustrations are generally arranged according to the sequence of tribes, genera, and species in FOC Volume 20–21, except when a figure includes more than one taxon, in which case the sequence is determined by the first species listed in the compound figure. Some highly variable species are illustrated on more than one plate to show morphological variations. Scale bars are given for some of the plates.

Names of recognized taxa are in boldface, and author names follow FOC. Each recognized taxon is followed by its Chinese name and the pinyin transliteration of that name. Important synonyms and misapplied names are cited before the pinyin names. Page numbers for the descriptions in FOC and for the figure number, volume number, and year of publication of the FRPS volume, as well as names of artists and sources of illustrations in the case of redrawings or reproductions, are listed in parentheses at the end of each caption.

Indexes to figure numbers are given for the Chinese names, their pinyin transliterations, and the scientific names.




Figure 1. 1–7. *Nouelia insignis* Franchet, 柚菊木 lu ju mu. —1. Flowering branch. —2. Leaf. —3. Capitulum. —4. Ray floret. —5. Disk floret. —6. Stamen. —7. Pappus. (FOC 10; FRPS 79: 73, pl. 13. 1996. —邓盈丰 Deng Yingfeng).




Figure 2. 1–4. **Adenocaulon himalaicum** Edgeworth, 和尚菜 he shang cai. —1. Habit. —2. Capitulum. —3. Bisexual floret. —4. Achene. (FOC 11; FRPS 75: 314, pl. 53: 1–4. 1979. —张荣厚, 冀朝祯 & 吴彰桦 Zhang Ronghou, Ji Chaozhen & Wu Zhanghua).




Figure 3. 1–13. *Leibnitzia anandria* (Linnaeus) Turczaninow, 大丁草 da ding cao. —1. Habit. —2. Portion of stem. —3. Basal leaf. —4. Upper leaf. —5. Capitulum and inflorescence. —6, 7. Phyllaries. —8. Ray floret. —9. Disk floret. —10. Stamens. —11. Style and style branches. —12. Achene. —13. Pappus bristle. (FOC 11. —陈建铸 Chen Chien-Chu; reproduced from 李惠林 Li Hui-Lin in 李惠林 Li Hui-Lin (ed.), Fl. Taiwan 4: 903, pl. 1240. 1978).




Figure 4. 1–4. *Leibnitzia nepalensis* (Kunze) Kitamura [*Gerbera kunzeana* A. Braun & Ascherson], 尼泊尔大丁草




Figure 7. 1–7. *Piloselloides hirsuta* (Forsskål) C. Jeffrey ex Cufodontis [*Gerbera piloselloides* (Linnaeus) Cassini], 兔耳一枝箭 *tu er yi zhi jian*. —1. Habit. —2, 3. Phyllaries. —4. Marginal female floret. —5. Central female floret. —6. Bisexual floret. —7. Achene and pappus. (FOC 15; FRPS 79: 94, pl. 17: 1–7. 1996. —邓晶发 Deng Jingfa).
