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Preface

As yin and yang balance each other, so have the study of the past and the present to go hand in hand. China with her long history remains a fascinating field of research: it is only to be hoped that present-day scholars in their great curiosity to follow and understand developments of today will not forget to look back and ignore the immense wealth of historical documents. One cannot fully understand China's present situation, unless one tries to return to the roots stretching far in the past.

For this reason, I rejoice whenever studies are published concerning earlier periods of China's history, to balance the immense number of books dealing with China's present-day political, economic, social and cultural developments. I congratulate my friend William Ch'en to have provided many students of the Chinese cultural heritage with a useful instrument of research. During the 1920's and '30's a large number of multi-volume collections were published in China. They incorporate original materials in the fields of the Confucian classics, history, philosophy and literature. Besides the Ssu-pu ts'ung-k'an (Shanghai, 1920-22), the Ssu-pu pei-yao (Shanghai, 1936) and the Ts'ung-shu chi-ch'eng (Shanghai, 1935-39), a fourth series was published between 1929 and 1941 by the Commercial Press in Shanghai:

Kuo-hsüeh chi-pen ts'ung-shu ssu-pai-chung. The Commercial Press of Taiwan, in 1968, made a reprint of these 400 titles available in 2,380 small volumes. It covers a wider area, includes more works on Buddhism and medicine, and, - a great solace for sinologists! - it is punctuated. Since this edition is cheaper and more easily available than the other three sets, many researchers will naturally have access to it. But so far no index has been made: William Ch'en's careful efforts have filled this gap: he has thus rendered an immense service to all scholars of China's past. Just looking at the subject index is already sufficient to wet one's appetite and say thanks to the careful compiler and to the publisher for their joint effort.

INTRODUCTION

The Kuo-hsüeh chi pen ts'ung shu (國學基本叢書) consisting of 400 works in 2380 volumes was originally published in Shanghai by the Commercial Press from 1929 to 1941, and was reprinted in Taiwan by the same publisher in 1968. The set contains valuable information which is essential to any serious study of the different aspects of Chinese culture. However, there has been so far no author, title or subject index: this makes it extremely difficult for a researcher to consult the collection. This guide is, therefore, intended to facilitate the use of this large collection. It is divided into four parts: 1. Main section; 2. Author index; 3. Title index; 4. Subject index.

The main section is a listing in the numerical order of the publications. The entry is under author, and where there is no author, under title. The titles are transcribed directly from the books following the Wade-Gile romanization system. This section is followed by the author index. All the works are arranged alphabetically under author, annotator, editor or compiler. The title index lists in alphabetical order all the titles in the collection. Under each title in romanization and Chinese, the name of the author is given in Chinese and the volume number is indicated. The last section contains the

subject index. This index is arranged according to Ssu k'u (四庫) system; Under each subject (Chinese in parenthesis), all the related titles are listed by their numbers in the collection.

Although the guide is intended to be an index to the collection, it can also be used as a bibliographical reference tool in locating basic Chinese works in the field of Chinese studies. In most cases I have carefully checked and verified the dates of birth and death of the authors.

Finally, I wish to acknowledge my indebtedness to E. Wilkinson for the use of his "The history of imperial China: a research guide, Cambridge, Mass., 1975", for the

translation of the technical terms in the section of the subject index.
