

はしがき

ことばを学習するとき、その背後にある文化を学ぶことは大変重要である。単にことばだけ覚えても、日本的な発想でものごとを判断すると、思いがけない誤解を招いたり、こちらの真意を理解してもらえなかったりする。

本書は、基本的な日米文化の相違点にスポットを当てながら、英語のリスニングの力を 向上させるための副教材である。

それぞれの問題は次のような構成になっている.

A リスニング

テープを聞きながら答える問題である。問題の種類はいろいろあるので、指示文に注意を払いたい。また、テープに録音された説明文にも留意したい。

少し難しい語句には注を施しているので、テープを聴くまえに、一読しておくことをすすめたい。

B ディクテーション

Aのリスニングに現われる、役立つ英文の書き取りの問題である。テープに録音された文とほぼ同一のものもあれば、語数の関係から、少し長さを加減したものもある。短縮形や音声変化などにも注意しながらチャレンジしてほしい。


The location and situation of each narration or dialog is explained at the beginning of each unit.
