

●編譯者的語 ●

你可知道,成語(或謂智語)不是可以隨便套用的?

成語〔習慣語〕在英文的學習中,佔據極重要的一環,無論說寫,適當地運用,都能够使辭意更加活潑,更有生命力,充分反映出人類日積月累的生活智慧。譬如下面這一句,"I've been working since six o'clock this morning, I think I'll call it a day."(從早六點就開始工作,我想今天工作得够了。) 其中成語 call it a day 的運用是多麼生動有力!

認得字却不懂意思

但面對英文成語,最令學習者頭痛的地方,便是,即使你認得每一單字,瞭解它的文法結構,可是當它們統統擺在一起時,往往不知所云。譬如說"She is no chicken." 光看字面,實在不易揣知它的正確意思是「她年紀不小了。」要不要再另試一個看看?也許你想的與它的原意正好相反——請試:"talk turkey"

懂得意思但不會用

然而,就算你懂得意思,卻也很難把握它完整的社會意義。換句話說,當你看到 "Ass about" 這個成語,懂得意思,卻拿捏不準應該在怎樣的場合,怎樣的情況下使用?什麼時候用,什麼時候不可用?它所蘊藏的語氣又如何?那一類的人才使用這句成語?你自己何時使

本書幫你解決困惑

針對諸如此類的問題,我們因此根據英美人士的使用習慣,分別在每一條成語之後,附加一個英文字母代號(見「如何正確使用成語」,第 vii 頁),以幫助讀者解決以上的問題。

這是本書的最大特色,也是坊間此類書籍的創學。因爲我們希望 經由這本「英文生活成語」,能够減少你的閱讀障礙,提高你的英文 寫作實力!

四大功能活學活用

- 一、作爲一本工具書,本書在實際應用方面,有很大的幫助,只 要秉持毅力,必有立竿見影的成效。
- 二、各條例句,生動活用,曉暢明白,可作爲英文背誦的脚本。 例: In his speech the Minister did not try to play down the difficulties the country is facing.
- 三、每日背誦數句,日積月界,可作爲日常會話的素材。 例: Will you turn the radio on, please? I want to hear the news.
- 四、腹笥充實,信手拈來,亦是寫信、作文的靈感泉源。
 - 例: I forgot to look over the letter before I signed it, and did not notice the mistakes.
- 五、經常使用,熟能生巧,對於翻譯的技巧必有所領悟,舉一反 三,終必百尺竿頭更上一層樓。
 - 例: It rained cats and dogs all day and we could not go out. 整日大雨傾盆,我們無法外出。

- 一、本書總收 1,500 多條最常用成語;共分兩部,部 I 將可歸類之成語,分門別類,如顏色 (Colours),食物與烹飪 (Food and Cooking),身體 (Parts of Body)等等共分十類。其餘難以歸類者則依照字母順序,編入部 II。
- 二、有關釋意部份,除非中文裏現成的習慣說法與原文的十分貼 切,否則編譯者寧願不嫌其繁,務求把原意說個明白,以免 讀者對原意的瞭解產生偏差。
 - 三、例句的選擇,務求活潑活用;中文翻譯,兼採直譯和意譯。 四、生字標音一律採用KK音標。
 - 五、每一單元之後,附有應用練習,加強學習功效。
- 六、書末附有英文索引,包括部 I 和部 II 的所有條目,依照英文字母順序排列,以便檢閱。
- 七、本書所依據的主要藍本爲 A. J. Worrall 所著,D. G. Sawer 所修訂的 "English Idioms for Foreign Students" 及 "More English Idioms for Foreign Students"。

─●何謂成語〔習慣語〕●─

就算是以英語(或美語)為母語的人,使用成語的時候不免也要 感到困擾。大部份我們所聽見的或是所使用的成語都有幾個共同的特 點:(一)耳熟能詳 (口根深蒂固 (口使用普遍 四容易明白。

idiom (成語) 和 idiomatic (慣用的) 這兩個字都是由希臘字 行變來的,其根本意思是「特有的」 (peculiar) 或是「各別的」 (individual)。成語的形成,沒有一定的公式可依循,也沒有什麼規則可遵守。我們知道每一種語言都各自有其獨特的個性,有許多成語,雖然不合邏輯,或者違反文法規則,但是大家都是這麼用的,或許「續非」便「成是」。就以中文來說也有這樣的例子:「養病」 (「病」豈非愈「養」愈大),「恢復疲勞」 (「疲勞」是要去除而非「恢復」)。

若要勉強把成語歸納出一個泛論,對於非以英語(美語)爲母語的人,大概可以這麼說:所謂成語,乃是由幾個字連結而成,但往往喪失其原來字面正確的意義,所表達出來的只是其中任何一個字隱晦的喻意,譬如: bed of roses, birds of a feather, black list, dark horse, read between the lines, toe the line.

第二個概括的說法是,以人體各部位的名稱爲根;由於日常生活的需要而創造出生動的成語爲數最多,例如:all my eye, burn one's fingers, stretch one's legs, take heart, pay through the nose, down in the mouth等。

最後一條通則是,相同的字往往因爲後面跟隨不同的字辭,而形成許多意義不一樣的「片語」,這也算是成語由來的主要方式之一。 譬如 look 這個字可組成下列不等的成語: look after, look ahead, look on, look like, look into, look, out, look over, look to, look up, look oneself.。而 make 這個字的組合情况更爲複雜 ,讀者可自行參考內文。

然而這樣的組合並非可以隨心所欲,而是必須爲一般人所共同接受的。有些比較可靠的字典,雖然在這方面的解釋算是十分詳細,但 是遺漏或不清楚的地方仍是在所難免。

下面例學二十對「習慣」和「不合習慣的」用語(等於錯誤用語), 算是這類困難一小部份的代表,希望讀者在對照之餘,提高這方面的 繁覺,只用 idiomatic 的部份,不可用 unidiomatic 的部份:

- 如何正確使用成語

本書每一條成語之後,都有一個英文字母代號,教你如何正確地使用成語。

- g 指「一般用法」(in general use),也就是就任何形式的 談話或寫作奧都會使用到的。
- p 指「格言或格言式的辭句」 (proverbs and proverbial expressions) ,也是各類英文中最常見的一種成語。
 - 指「正式成語」(formal idioms) 而言,限於高雅談話或文學創作中使用。
 - c 指使用於非正式文章或談話中的「俗語」(colloquial idioms), 但使用者並非必然指未受教育者,毋寧說是一種比較非正式 而優雅的英文。
 - * 指「俚語」(slang idioms),使用於非常不正式的談話中, 通常爲某一特定階級或一羣人所使用。
 - * 成語在英文的學習中,佔着相當重要的一環,而學會如何正確地使用,更是要 緊,如此才是與學到了「活學活用」的活英文。
