Build this House was commissioned by Cycle of Songs, an Arts Council England funded project commissioned by Cambridge City Council, devised by the Pilot Theatre and Historyworks to mark the Tour de France visit to Cambridge on 7 July 2014. The text, compiling verses from the Books of Ezra and Sirach, is based on that of an anthem entitled *Hearken unto me, ye holy children*, written in 1728 by Maurice Greene for the Founder's Day service at King's College, which takes place every year on 25 March.

The first performance was given by Milton Road Primary School Choir led by Choir Leaders Anna-Louise Lawrence and Becky Sharp, and the Choristers of King's College with organist Tom Etheridge, conducted by Stephen Cleobury. The organist for the premier of the SATB version was Douglas Tang.
