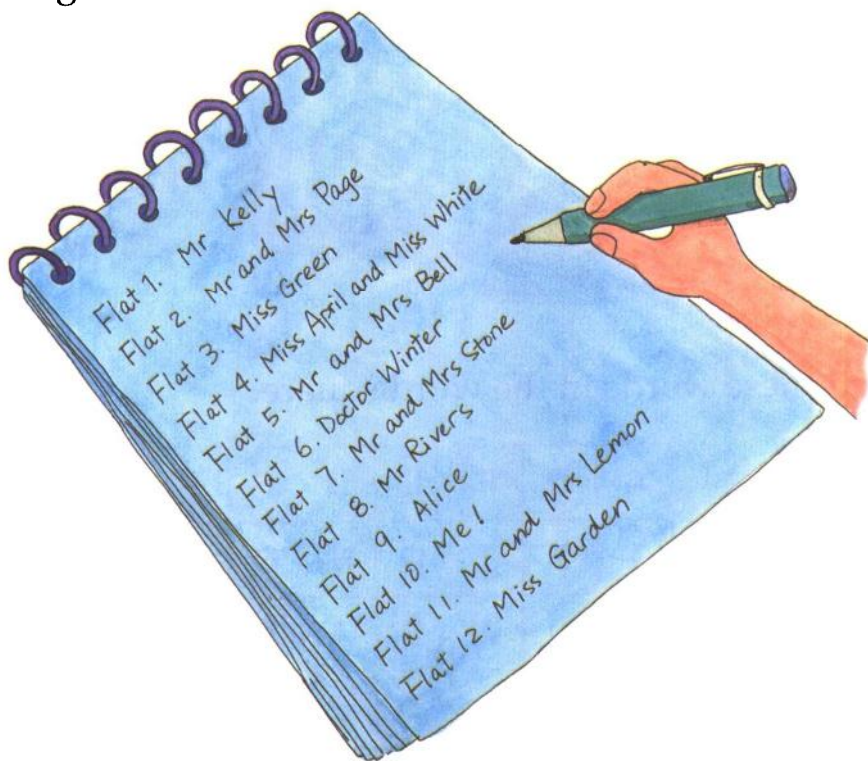

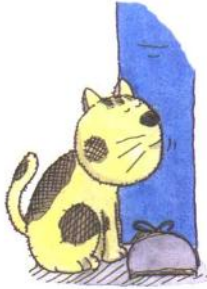

'Do you know Smokey?' 'Does she visit you?' and 'Have you seen her today?'

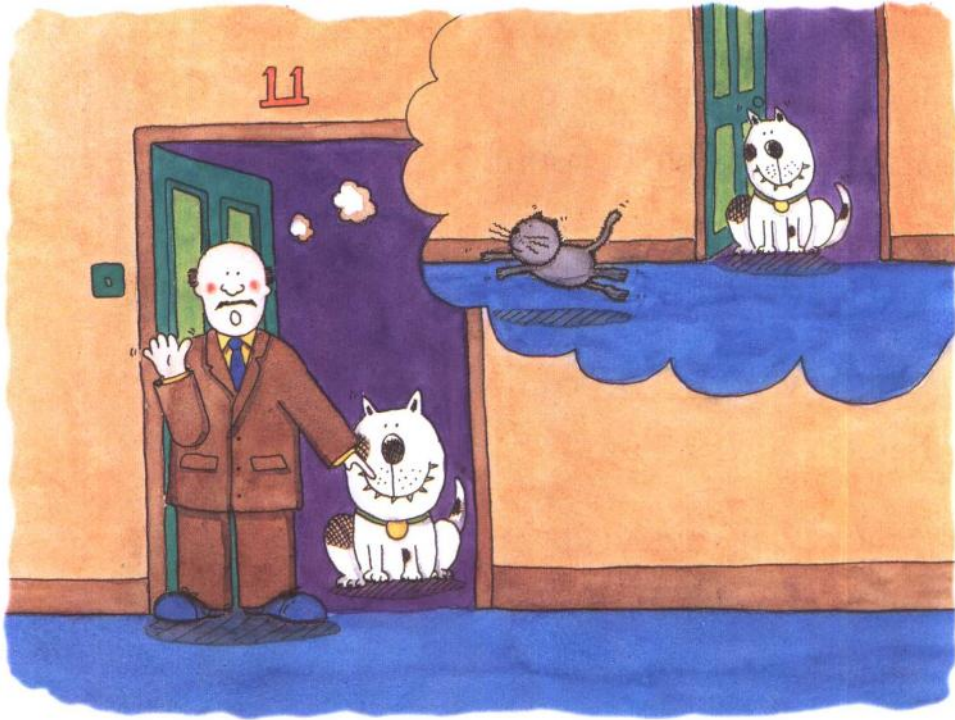
Everybody said: 'Yes, she often comes here. I usually feed her. But I haven't seen her today.'

Mr Lemon came to the door. There was an enormous dog behind him.

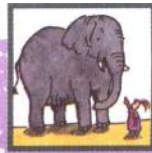
'Smokey never comes here,' said Mr Lemon.

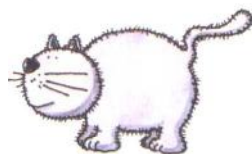
