②I thought that such an important paper as the one we are waiting for should have a little extra protection.

我认为正如我们正在等待的那种重要文件应当有些额外的保护。

他有许多朋友。

**应用特点**

1. a lot of (lots of)接复数可数名词(或不可数名词);2. a lot (= lot)作状语,修饰动词或形容词比较级;3. a lot of 只用于口语肯定句中,在否定句或疑问句中则用 much 或 many。

**相关例句**

①She laughed a lot.

她笑得厉害。

②He's a lot older than she is.

他比她年纪大得多。

许多因素,既有遗传的也有环境所致,影响着有关健康行为的发展。

**应用特点** be about to (do)比 be going to (do)更表示最近的将来。

前者指“最近的将来”, 后者指“不久的将来”。前者是书面语, 后者是口语。前者不可加时间副词, 后者可以。其否定式为 be not about to do 表示“不愿意”、“不准备”……。

**相关例句** ①When one is about to act, one must reason first.

凡事应先思而后行。

②We were about to gather up our things and return to our car when a man appeared.

我们正准备收拾好我们的东西回到车里时, 一个男人来到我们的跟前。
